

Crowning Rose Hat by DROPS Design

Crocheted hat in DROPS Muskat. The piece is worked with squares. Size: One-size.

SIZE:

One-size

Fits head-size: 54-56 cm.

YARN:

DROPS MUSKAT from Garnstudio (belongs to yarn group B)

100 g colour 08, off white

50 g colour 09, nutmeg

50 g colour 85, mustard

50 g colour 87, pomegranate

50 g colour 92, sweet orchid

CROCHET HOOK:

DROPS CROCHET HOOK SIZE 4 MM.

CROCHET TENSION:

22 treble crochets in width and 11 rows in height = 10 x 10 cm.

1 square measures approx. 7.5 x 7.5 cm.

Hook size is only a guide. If you get too many stitches on 10 cm, change to a larger hook size. If you get too few stitches on 10 cm, change to a smaller hook size.

EXPLANATIONS FOR THE PATTERN:

PATTERN:

See diagram A.1.

COLOURS:

Work different colour combinations as follows:

Square 1:

CAST ON + ROUND 1: 09, nutmeg

ROUND 2: 85, mustard

ROUND 3: 87, pomegranate

ROUND 4: 08, off white

Square 2:

CAST ON + ROUND 1: 92, sweet orchid

ROUND 2: 09, nutmeg

ROUND 3: 85, mustard

ROUND 4: 08, off white

Square 3:

CAST ON + ROUND 1: 85, mustard

ROUND 2: 87, pomegranate

ROUND 3: 92, sweet orchid

ROUND 4: 08, off white

Square 4:

CAST ON + ROUND 1: 87, pomegranate

ROUND 2: 92, sweet orchid

ROUND 3: 09, nutmeg

ROUND 4: 08, off white

CHANGING COLOURS:

For a neat transition when changing colours, work the last slip stitch on the round with the new colour.

CROCHET INFORMATION:

At the beginning of each round of treble crochets, replace the first treble crochet with 3 chain stitches. Finish the round with 1 slip stitch in the 3rd chain stitch at the beginning of

the round.

At the beginning of each round starting with double crochets, replace the first double crochet with 1 chain stitch. Finish the round with 1 slip stitch in this chain stitch.

INCREASE TIP:

Increase 1 treble crochet by working 2 treble crochets in the same stitch.

START THE PIECE HERE:

HAT - SHORT OVERVIEW OF THE PIECE:

The top of the hat is worked in the round, then 6 squares are worked, which are crocheted together into a band and crocheted to the top of the hat. The brim is worked to finish.

SQUARE:

Use crochet hook size 3 mm and DROPS Muskat. Read COLOURS and CHANGING COLOURS. Work squares according to diagram A.1 in the different colour combinations.

Work 1 x square-1, 2 x square-2, 2 x square-3 and 1 x square-4 = 6 squares.

1 square measures approx. 7½ x 7½ cm.

REMEMBER THE CROCHET TENSION!

TOP OF HAT:

Work 5 chain stitches with hook size 3 mm and DROPS Muskat. Form them into a ring with 1 slip stitch in the first chain stitch.

ROUND 1: Work 11 treble crochets around the ring – read CROCHET INFORMATION!

ROUND 2: 2 treble crochets in each stitch = 22 stitches.

ROUND 3: * 2 treble crochets in the first/next stitch, 1 treble crochet in the next stitch *, work from *-* to the end of the round = 33 stitches.

ROUND 4: * 2 treble crochets in the first/next stitch, 1 treble crochet in each of the next 2 stitches *, work from *-* to the end of the round = 44 stitches.

ROUND 5: * 2 treble crochets in the first/next stitch, 1 treble crochet in each of the next 3 stitches *, work from *-* to the end of the round = 55 stitches.

ROUND 6: * 2 treble crochets in the first/next stitch, 1 treble crochet in each of the next 4 stitches *, work from *-* to the end of the round = 66 stitches.

ROUND 7: * 2 treble crochets in the first/next stitch, 1 treble crochet in each of the next 5 stitches *, work from *-* to the end of the round = 77 stitches.

Lay out the squares in the following order: Square-1, square-2, square-3, square-2, square-4, square-3.

Use hook size 3 mm and colour off white. Lay 2 squares edge to edge. Start in one corner, * insert the hook from the right side through the back loop on one square, then from the right side through the back loop on the second square, pick up the strand and pull it through both loops on the hook *, work from *-* along the side. NOTE! Work 1 stitch in each corner and 1 stitch in each treble crochet/chain stitch. Work all squares together into a band, then work the first and last square together to form a ring.


Work a round of treble crochets: 1 treble crochet in each treble crochet and 1 treble in each corner (between the squares) along the top edge of the band with colour off white = 13 treble crochets on the first 5 squares and 12 treble crochets on the last square (do not work 1 treble crochet in the last corner) = 77 stitches.

Crochet together the top edge of the band and the top of the hat in the same way as the squares were crocheted together.


BRIM:


Using colour off white, work 1 treble crochet in each of the 15 treble crochets/chain stitches and 3 treble crochets between 2 squares along the bottom edge of the band = 108 stitches. Work 5 rounds of treble crochets and increase 8 treble crochets evenly spaced on each round = 148 treble crochets. Work 1 round of double crochets with 2 strands colour off white, working 1 double crochet in each stitch. Cut and fasten the strands.

Diagram explanations

 = Start here! Work 4 chain stitches and form them into a ring with 1 slip stitch in the first chain stitch = point on circle

 = 1 chain stitch

 = 1 slip stitch in 3rd chain stitch at beginning of round

 = 1 treble crochet around chain-stitch ring/chain-space

 = 1 treble crochet around the 3 chain-stitches from previous round
