STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

alt - alternate
beg - beginning
cm - centimetres

BACK

Using 4mm needles and thumb method cast on **99** [**111:123:133:145:155**] sts.

1st Row. * K1, p1, rep from * to last st, k1.

2nd Row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to end.

1st and 2nd rows will now be referred to as 1x1 rib.

Work in 1x1 rib for **5** [**5:5:6:6:6**]cm, (**2** [**2:2:2½:2½:2½**]in), ending with a ws row.

Next Row. Knit to end inc **1** [**1:1:0:0:0**] sts in centre of row for 1st, 2nd and 3rd sizes only, dec **0** [**0:0:0:0:1**] sts in centre of row for 6th size only.

100 [**112:124:133:145:154**] sts.

Change to 4mm needles and proceed as follows:-

Next Row. Purl.

1st Row. Knit.

2nd Row. Purl.

1st and 2nd rows will now be referred to as st-st (stocking stitch).

Work 2 rows more in st-st.

** **1st Row.** K2 * knit into next st wrapping yarn 3 times round needle, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

2nd Row. P2, ybk, * slip next 3 sts purlways dropping the extra loops, slip these 3 sts back onto left hand needle, (k1, yfwd, k1) into the front of these sts, rep from * to last 2 sts, p2.

1st and 2nd rows set eyelet patt.

Work 4 rows in st-st. **

Rep from ** to ** once more then 1st and 2nd rows once more.

Next Row. Knit to end dec **0** [**0:0:1:1:0**] sts in centre of row for 4th and 5th sizes only.

100 [**112:124:132:144:154**] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Working in st-st (throughout) cont until back measures **35** [**35:35:36:37:38**]cm, (**13¾** [**13¾:13¾:14:14½:15**]in), ending with a ws row. ***

SHAPE ARMHOLES

Cast off **6** [**6:8:9:11:12**] sts at beg of next 2 rows. **88** [**100:108:114:122:130**] sts.

Work **4** [**4:4:4:6:8**] rows dec 1 st at each end of every row.

80 [**92:100:106:110:114**] sts.

Work **5** [**11:13:13:13:13**] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row. **74** [**80:86:92:96:100**] sts.

Cont without shaping until armholes measure **20** [**22:24:25:26:27**]cm, (**8** [**8¾:9½:9¾:10¼:10¾**]in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE SHOULDERS

Cast off **9** [**10:11:12:13:14**] sts at beg of next 2 rows. **56** [**60:64:68:70:72**] sts.

Cast off **9** [**10:12:13:14:15**] sts at beg of next 2 rows. **38** [**40:40:42:42:42**] sts.

Leave rem **38** [**40:40:42:42:42**] sts on a stitch holder.

FRONT

Work as given for Back to ***.

SHAPE ARMHOLE AND DIVIDE FOR FRONT OPENING

Next Row. Cast off **6** [**6:8:9:11:12**] sts (armhole edge), k39 [**45:49:52:56:60**], turn, leave rem **54** [**60:66:70:76:81**] sts on a stitch holder.

40 [**46:50:53:57:61**] sts.

Working on these **40** [**46:50:53:57:61**] sts only proceed as follows:-

Next Row. Purl.

Work **4** [**4:4:4:6:8**] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row.

36 [**42:46:49:51:53**] sts.

Work **5** [**11:13:13:13:13**] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row. **33** [**36:39:42:44:46**] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures **9** [**11:12:13:14:15**]cm, (**3½** [**4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6**]in), ending with a rs row.

SHAPE NECK

Cast off **4** [**4:5:6:6:6**] sts, purl to end. **29** [**32:34:36:38:40**] sts.

Next Row. Knit.

1st Row. Cast off 2 sts, purl to end. **27** [**30:32:34:36:38**] sts.

2nd Row. Knit.

Rep 1st and 2nd rows twice more then 1st row once more.

21 [**24:26:28:30:32**] sts.

Work **5** [**7:5:5:5:5**] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row. **18** [**20:23:25:27:29**] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures **20** [**22:24:25:26:27**]cm, (**8** [**8¾:9½:9¾:10¼:10¾**]in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE SHOULDER

Next Row. Cast off **9** [**10:11:12:13:14**] sts, knit to end. **9** [**10:12:13:14:15**] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

Cast off rem **9** [**10:12:13:14:15**] sts.

Working on rem **54** [**60:66:70:76:81**] sts, with rs facing, slip 8 sts onto a stitch holder, rejoin yarn to rem **46** [**52:58:62:68:73**] sts and knit to end.

Next Row. Cast off **6** [**6:8:9:11:12**] sts (armhole edge), purl to end. **40** [**46:50:53:57:61**] sts.

Work **4** [**4:4:4:6:8**] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in every row. **36** [**42:46:49:51:53**] sts.

Work **5** [**11:13:13:13:13**] rows dec 1 st at armhole edge in next and every foll alt row. **33** [**36:39:42:44:46**] sts.

Cont without shaping until armhole measures **9** [**11:12:13:14:15**]cm, (**3½** [**4¼:4¾:5¼:5½:6**]in), ending with a ws row.

SHAPE NECK

Cast off **4** [**4:5:6:6:6**] sts, knit to end. **29** [**32:34:36:38:40**] sts.

Next Row. Purl.

1st Row. Cast off 2 sts, knit to end.
27 [30:32:34:36:38] sts.
2nd Row. Purl.
 Rep 1st and 2nd rows 3 times more.
21 [24:26:28:30:32] sts.
 Work **5** [7:5:5:5:5] rows dec 1 st at neck edge in next and every foll alt row.
18 [20:23:25:27:29] sts.
 Cont without shaping until armhole measures **20** [22:24:25:26:27]cm, (**8** [8¾:9½:9¾:10¼:10¾]in), ending with a rs row.

SHAPE SHOULDER

Next Row. Cast off **9** [10:11:12:13:14] sts, purl to end.
9 [10:12:13:14:15] sts.
Next Row. Knit.
 Cast off rem **9** [10:12:13:14:15] sts.

NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam. With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles pick up and knit **33** [33:35:35:35:35] sts evenly along right side of neck, knit across **38** [40:40:42:42:42] sts left on a stitch holder at back of neck as follows:-
 k**18** [19:19:20:20:20] inc in next st,
 k**19** [20:20:21:21:21] pick up and knit **33** [33:35:35:35:35] sts evenly along left side of neck.
105 [107:111:113:113:113] sts.
 Starting with 1st row of 1x1 rib work for 2.5cm, (1in).
 Cast off in rib.

ARMHOLE BORDERS (Both alike)

Join left shoulder seam. With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles pick up and knit **113** [121:137:151:163:167] sts evenly all round armhole edge.
 Starting with 2nd row of 1x1 rib work for 2.5cm (1in).
 Cast off in rib.

UNDERLAY

Using 3¼mm needles and thumb method cast on **9** sts.
1st Row. K1, * k1tbl, p1, rep from * to end.
2nd Row. * K1tbl, p1, rep from * to last st, k1.
 These 2 rows set rib.
 Working in rib cont until underlay is of sufficient length to go up left front

opening to top of neckband when slightly stretched.
 Cast off in rib.
 Mark positions for buttons first one 1cm, (0.5in), from top and last one 5cm, (2in), from lower edge.

OVERLAY

With rs facing, using 3¼mm needles rejoin yarn to 8 sts left on a stitch holder and proceed as follows:-
Next Row. * P1, k1tbl, rep from * to end, cast on 1 st (cast on st to be used for sewing). 9 sts.
1st Row. K1, * p1, k1tbl, rep from * to end.
2nd Row. * P1, k1tbl, rep from * to last st, k1.
 1st and 2nd rows set rib.
 Work in rib for 5cm, (2in), ending with a ws row.
Next Row (Buttonhole row). (P1, k1tbl) twice, cast off 1 st, p1, k1tbl, k1.
Next Row. K1, p1, k1tbl, p1, cast on 1 st, (p1, k1tbl) twice.
 Cont in rib until overlay measures exactly the same as Underlay working buttonhole as before to correspond with marker on Underlay, ending with a ws row.
 Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Join side and armhole border seams.
 Sew overlay to right front opening edge and along neckband, sew underlay to left front opening edge and along neckband. Sew underlay in position behind overlay. Sew on buttons. Pin out garment to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
