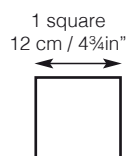

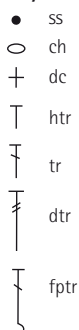

STITCHES & ABBREVIATIONS

NB These instructions use UK crochet terms throughout - US terms are given in brackets below where applicable

beg - beginning

ch - chain

cm - centimetres

dc - double crochet (US single crochet)

dtr - double treble (US treble)

htr - half treble (US half double crochet)

rep - repeat

rnd(s) - round(s)

tr - treble (US double crochet)

sp(s) - space(s)

ss - slip stitch

st(s) - stitch(es)

yoh - yarn over hook

fptr - front post treble - yoh, insert hook from front to back to front around post of indicated stitch, yoh and pull up a loop, (yoh and pull through 2 loops on hook) twice.

bprr - back post treble - yoh, insert hook from back to front to back around post of indicated stitch, yoh and pull up a loop, (yoh and pull through 2 loops on hook) twice.

Pattern notes

(important - please read first)

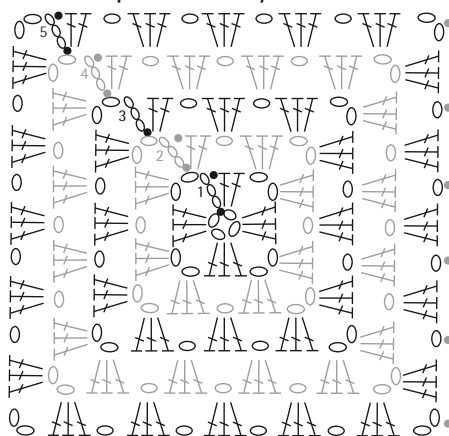
Joining - each square is joined with the join-as-you-go technique and following the joining diagram.

To measure tension, make one full granny square and block it to finished size.

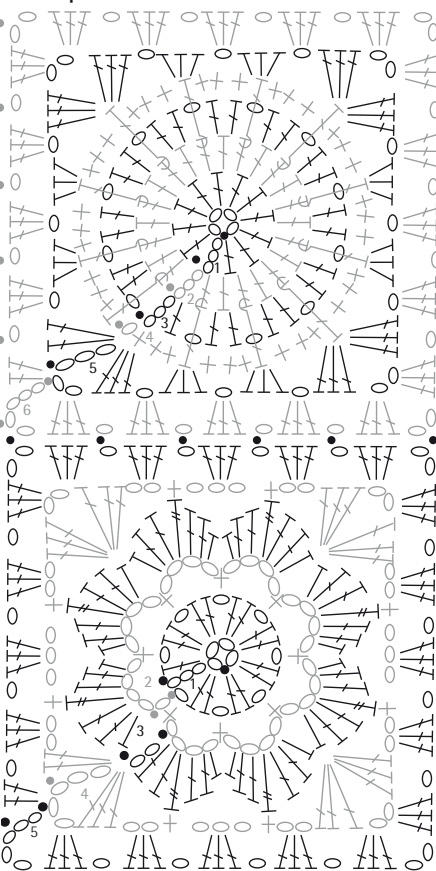
When changing colour - ss with new colour where required to finish rnd.

Do not cut the yarn on every rnd but carry it up with you catching it behind at the end of every rnd.

Square 1 - Granny



Square 2 - Medallion



Square 1 - Granny

Make 60 in total

A & B	1	I & H	12
B & C	3	L & K	15
F & E	5	N & M	9
H & G	8	O & N	7

Using colour A, or (B, F, H, I, L, N, O) make 4ch, ss into first ch to form a ring.

1st Rnd. 5ch (counts as 1tr and 2ch sp), (3tr in ring, 2ch) 3 times, 2tr in ring, ss in 3rd of beg 5ch. (4 groups of 3tr)

Change to colour B, or (C, E, G, H, K, M, N).

2nd Rnd. Ss in first 2ch sp, 5ch, 3tr in same 2ch sp as ss, * 1ch, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in next 2ch sp, rep from * twice more, 1ch, 2tr in the same sp as beg 5ch, ss in 3rd of beg 5ch. (8 groups of 3tr)

Change to colour A, or (B, F, H, I, L, N, O).

3rd Rnd. Ss in first 2ch sp, 5ch, 3tr in same 2ch sp as ss, * 1ch, 3tr in next 1ch sp, 1ch, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in next 2ch sp, rep from * twice more, 1ch, 3tr in next 1ch sp, 1ch, 2tr in the same sp as beg 5ch, ss in 3rd of beg 5ch. (12 groups of 3tr)

Change to colour B, or (C, E, G, H, K, M, N).

4th Rnd. Ss in first 2ch sp, 5ch, 3tr in same 2ch sp as ss, * 1ch, (3tr in next 1ch sp, 1ch) twice, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in next 2ch sp, rep from * twice more, 1ch, (3tr in next 1ch sp, 1ch) twice, 2tr in the same sp as beg 5ch, ss in 3rd of beg 5ch. (16 groups of 3tr)

Change to colour P.

5th Rnd (for 1st square). Ss in first 2ch sp, 5ch, 3tr in same 2ch sp as ss, * 1ch, (3tr in next ch sp, 1ch) 3 times, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) in next 2ch sp, rep from * twice more, 1ch, (3tr in next 1ch sp, 1ch) 3 times, 2tr in the same sp as beg 5ch, ss in 3rd of beg 5ch. (20 groups of 3tr)

Fasten off.

For all subsequent squares work 5th rnd of Square 1, 6th rnd of Square 2 and 5th rnd

Square 3 - Flower

of Square 3 as given for 5th rnd of Square 1 at same time using the join-as-you-go technique as follows:-

Join-as-you-go technique

1: For next square crochet 3 sides of 5th rnd, stopping after 3tr and 1ch in corner 2ch sp.

2: You will begin your joining by using a ss in the corner of square to the left to connect the two motifs. Either, place the squares next to each other or hold your squares together with the wrong sides facing each other and ss into the adjoining corner of the next motif.

3: Complete the corner of right side square as usual by making 3tr in corner 2ch sp. Note that you are only crocheting into the square on the right, not into both squares.

4: 1ch, ss in next ch sp of square on the left. Work 3tr in next ch sp of square on the right. 1ch, ss in next ch sp of square on the left.

5: rep steps 4 to 5 until you reach the next corner.

6: 1ch, 2tr in the same sp as beg 5ch.

7: insert hook in 3rd of beg 5ch and corner 2ch sp of adjoining square.

8: Ss to join.

Continue joining using this technique until all squares are joined.

Connect squares in the same manner. When you have more squares joined the new squares will be connected over 2 or 3 sides, the only difference is that you will need to join the square to two adjacent squares. This is done in the same manner, when you get to the corner where all four squares meet, work 3tr in corner, ss to square 1, ss to square 3 then 3tr in same corner.

Square 2 - Medallion

Make 30 in total

B, A & C 2
D, F & E 6
K, J & L 14
O, N & M 8

With colour B, or (D, K, O) make 4ch, ss into first ch to form a ring.

1st Rnd. 3ch (counts as 1tr), 11tr in ring, ss to top ch of beg 3ch. 12 sts.

Change to colour A, or (F, J, N).

2nd Rnd. 3ch (counts as 1tr), 1tr in st at base of 3ch, 2tr in every st to end, ss to top ch of beg 3ch. 24tr.

3rd Rnd. 3ch (counts as 1tr), 1tr in st at base of 3ch, 1ch, miss next st, * 2tr in next st, 1ch, miss next st, rep from * to end, ss to top ch of beg 3ch. 12 1ch sps and 24tr.

Change to colour C, or (E, L, M).

4th Rnd. 1ch (does not count as a st), 1dc in st at the base of 1ch, 2dc in next st, working in front of next 1ch sp 1fp around missed st 2 rnds below, * 1dc in next st, 2dc in next st, working in front of next ch sp 1fp around missed st 2 rnds below, rep from * to end, ss to first st. 48 sts.

Change to B, or (D, K, O).

5th Rnd. 5ch (counts as 1tr and 2ch sp), 3tr in same st as 5ch, 1ch, miss next 2 sts, * (3tr in next fp, 1ch, miss next 3 sts) twice, (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) all in next st, 1ch, miss next 3 sts, rep from * twice more, 3htr in next fp, 1ch, miss next 3 sts, 3htr in next fp, 1ch, miss next 4 sts, 2tr in the same st as beg 5ch, ss in 3rd of beg 5ch. (16 groups of 3 sts)

Change to colour P.

6th Rnd. Work as given for 5th rnd of Square 1, joining as you go. Fasten off.

Square 3 - Flower

Make 30 in total

F, E & D 4
I, H & G 10
J, K & L 16

With colour F, or (I, J) make 4ch, ss into first ch to form a ring.

1st Rnd. 4ch (counts as 1tr and 1ch sp, (2tr, 1ch) 7 times all in ring, 1tr in ring, ss in 3rd of beg 4ch. 16tr and 8 1ch sps.

Change to colour E, or (H, K).

2nd Rnd. Ss in first 1ch sp, 1ch, 1dc in same 1ch sp, (4ch, miss next 2 sts, 1dc in next 1ch sp) 7 times, 4ch, miss next 2 sts, ss in first dc. 8 4ch sps.

3rd Rnd. Ss in first 4ch sp, 2ch (counts as 1htr), (2tr, 1dtr, 2tr, 1htr) all in same 4ch sp as 2ch, * miss next st, (1htr, 2tr, 1dtr, 2tr, 1htr) all in next 4ch sp, rep from * 6 times more, ss to top of beg 2ch. 56 sts.

Change to colour D or (G, L).

4th Rnd. 5ch (counts as 1tr and 2ch sp), 3tr in same st as 5ch, 2ch, miss next 2 sts, 1dc in next dtr, 3ch, miss next 6 sts, 1dc in next dtr, 2ch, miss next 3 sts, * (3tr, 2ch, 3tr) all in sp between next 2htr, 2ch, miss next 3 sts, 1dc in next dtr, 3ch, miss next 6 sts, 1dc in next dtr, 2ch, miss next 3 sts, rep from * twice more, 2tr in the same st as beg 5ch, ss in 3rd of beg 5ch. 16 ch sps.

Change to colour P.

5th Rnd. Work as given for 5th rnd of Square 1, joining as you go. Fasten off.

Edging

Join colour P to any corner 2ch sp of blanket.

1st Rnd. 5ch (counts as first 1tr and 2ch sp), 2tr in same 2ch sp as ss, 1tr in every st and 1ch sp to next corner 2ch sp, * (2tr, 2ch, 2tr) all in corner 2ch sp, 1tr in every st and ch sp to next corner 2ch sp, rep from * twice more, 1tr in the same sp as beg 5ch, ss in 3rd of beg 5ch.

Change to colour C.

2nd Rnd. Ss in first 2ch sp, 4ch (counts as first 1htr and 2ch sp) and 2htr in same 2ch sp as ss, 1bptr around every st to next corner 2ch sp, * (2htr, 2ch, 2htr) all in corner 2ch sp, 1bptr around every st to next corner 2ch sp, rep from * twice more, 1htr in the same sp as beg 4ch, ss in 2nd of beg 4ch.

Change to colour P.

3rd Rnd. As 2nd rnd.

TO COMPLETE

Pin out blanket to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
