SKILL LEVEL – BEGINNER

SIZES

XS (S, M, L) (1X, 2X, 3X) (4X, 5X)

Finished Chest About 31 1/2 (33 1/2, 36, 38 1/2) (41 1/2, 45, 48 1/2) (53, 57 1/2) in. (80 (85, 91.5, 98) (105.5, 114.5, 123) (134.5, 146) cm)

Finished Length About 11 1/2 (11 1/2, 12, 12) (12 1/2, 12 1/2, 13) (13, 13 1/2) in. (29 (29, 30.5, 30.5) (32, 32, 33) (33, 34.5) cm), not including straps

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® DIY GLOW CHENILLE (Art. #207)
#144 Purple 5 (5, 6, 6) (7, 7, 8) (9, 10) balls
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Note: Choose the length needle listed for your size.

Circular knitting needle size 10 (6 mm) –
24 in. (60 cm) long (for size XS only)
32 in. (80 cm) long (for sizes S, M, and L only)
40 in. (100 cm) long (for sizes 1X, 2X, and 3X only)
47 in. (120 cm) long (for sizes 4X and 5X only)

GAUGE

10 sts = about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm) over St st worked in rnds (k every st of every rnd).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



NOTES

1. Top is worked in one piece in the round
2. Straps are worked directly onto top edge of the Top.

TOP

With circular needle, cast on 70 (74, 80, 86) (92, 100, 108) (118, 128) sts.

Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left needle with the working yarn from the right needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Rnds 1-12: * K1, p1; rep from * around.

Work in St st worked in rnds (k every st of every rnd) until piece measures about 11 1/2 (11 1/2, 12, 12) (12 1/2, 12 1/2, 13) (13, 13 1/2) in. (29 (29, 30.5, 30.5) (32, 32, 33) (33, 34.5) cm) from beg.

Bind off.

Note: The Top was designed in reverse st st worked in the round. For ease of knitting, we made the Top in St st worked in the round – then simply turn it ‘inside out’ when you’re done knitting!

Straps

Try on Top and place 2 markers on front and 2 markers on back for desired placement of 2 straps.

From RS, with circular needle, pick up and k3 (3, 3, 3) (4, 4, 4) (5, 5) sts evenly spaced along top edge of Top at one marker. Do not turn work. * Slide sts to other end of needle and knit them, pulling yarn tightly across the back of the work, (do not turn work); rep from * until Strap measures about 12 (12 1/2, 13, 13 1/2) (14, 14 1/2, 15) (15 1/2, 16) in. (30.5 (32, 33, 34.5) (35.5, 37, 38) (39.5, 40.5) cm) long.

Bind off.

Rep to make a Strap at each of the remaining 3 markers.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

rnd(s) = round(s)

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch
