

<i>UK Crochet Terms</i>	<i>US Crochet Terms</i>	<i>How to</i>
Double Crochet (dc)	Single Crochet (sc)	Insert hook into the stitch, yarn over hook, pull up a loop, yarn over hook, pull through both loops on hook.
Half Treble Crochet (htr)	Half Double Crochet (hdc)	Yarn over hook, insert hook into stitch, yarn over hook, draw up a loop, (there will be 3 loops on the hook), yarn over hook, pull through all 3 loops.
Treble Crochet (tr)	Double Crochet (dc)	Yarn over hook, insert hook into stitch, yarn overhook, draw up a loop, (there will be 3 loops on hook), yarn over hook, pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 2 loops.
Double Treble Crochet (dtr)	Triple Crochet (tr)	Yarn over hook twice, insert hook into stitch, yarn over hook, draw up a loop, (there will be 4 loops on hook), yarn over hook, pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through 2 loops, yarn over hook, pull through remaining 2 loops.
Triple Treble Crochet (ttr)	Double Treble Crochet (dtr)	Yarn over hook 3 times, insert hook into stitch, yarn over hook, draw through stitch (there will be 5 loops on hook), yarn over hook, pull through 2 loops (now there will be 4 loops on hook), yarn over hook, pull through 2 loops; yarn over and pull through 2 loops twice more.
Tension	Gauge	Number of stitches and rows per inch using your specified hook and yarn.
Yarn Over Hook (yoh)	Yarn Over (yo)	Wrap yarn over the top of the hook and round, so you are ready to start the next stitch.
