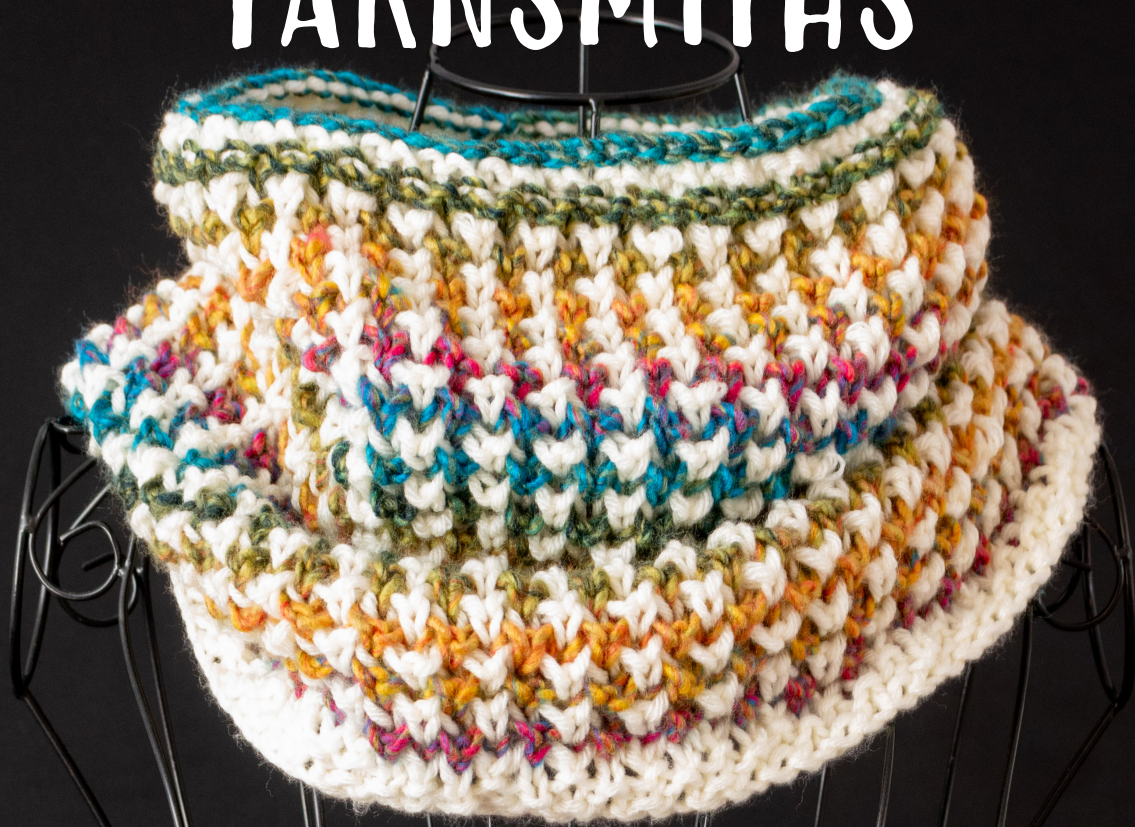

# Bee Stitch Cowl

## MATERIALS AND MEASUREMENTS

<b>Yarnsmiths Create Chunky</b>		
Yarn A	1	Ball
<b>Yarnsmiths Lagoon Chunky</b>		
Yarn B	1	Ball
6.5mm and 7mm Knitting Needles Yarn Needle

Please note that the limitations of the printing process mean the actual colour will not always precisely match the colours shown in the photograph.

### IMPORTANT

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect item if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

### TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the garment. 12 sts and 20 rows to make 10cm, 4ins in pattern on 6.5mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10cm, then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10cm, then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

### ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

**K** - Knit; **P** - Purl;  
**K1b** - Knit 1 into the row below.

### NOTE

This pattern works best if you knit loosely throughout.

## COWL

Using 6.5mm needles and Yarn A, cast on 76 stitches.

Work 4 rows of moss stitch as follows:

**Row 1** - \*kl, pl; repeat from \* to end of row.

**Row 2** - \*pl, kl; repeat from \* to end of row.

Work these 2 rows once more.

Change to 7mm needles and add in Yarn B. Do not cut either yarn, we will work with both yarns and carry them up as we knit.

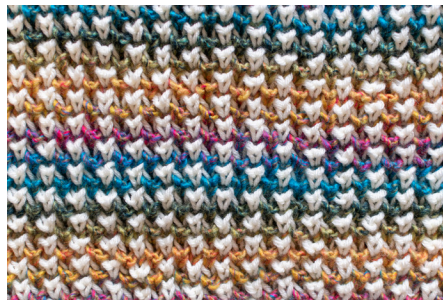
The following 4 rows form the bee stitch pattern:

**Row 1** - In Yarn B, \*k1b, kl\*; repeat from \* to end of row.

**Row 2** - In Yarn B, k.

**Row 3** - In Yarn A, \*kl, k1b\*; repeat from \* to end of row.

**Row 4** - In Yarn A, k.



Work these 4 rows until piece measures approximately 36cm from cast on edge.

Finish on a row 4 and then change to 6.5mm needles.

Work rows 1 and 2 only of bee stitch pattern (once).

In Yarn A, work 2 rows of moss stitch as before.

Cast off loosely in k using Yarn B.

Sew up seam and weave in ends.
