Bobbi – Garter Stitch Jacket Knitting Pattern in Bo Peep DK

Tension

It is essential to work to the stated tension in order to achieve your desired fabric and garment size. You should always start by knitting a tension square before knitting the full garment.





If you have fewer stitches than stated, you will need to go down needle sizes until the correct tension is achieved.

If you have more stitches, you will need to go up needle sizes. Please check individual patterns for tension before starting your garment.

Finishing

We recommend using mattress stitch for seaming your garment. When sewing in the sleeve you will need to fold the sleeve in half and while matching the fold to the shoulder seam, sew in position between the markers.

Once your garment is complete, it is essential to block your knitting. Pin your garment out to the size stated in the pattern. Cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.

Equipment

One pair of 3.25mm (UK10/US3) knitting needles.

One pair of 4mm (UK8/US6) knitting needles.

Stitch holders.

Four hinged stitch markers.

2 [2:2:3:3:3] buttons.

Tension

21 sts and 42 rows to 10cm measured over garter stitch using 4mm needles or size needed to achieve stated tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure success.





Left Front

Using 3.25mm needles cast on 22 [25:27:30:32:35] sts.

Row 1 (RS): Side Edge. K to end.

Row 2 (WS): K to end.

These 2 rows set garter stitch and are repeated.

Work 2 more rows in g-st.

Change to 4mm needles and cont in g-st (throughout) until Left Front measures 11 [14:17:18:21:23]cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Place markers at end of last row to identify armhole.

Cont until Left Front measures 16 [19:23:27:28:31]cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Shape Neck

Next row (RS): K to last 2 [2:2:3:3:4] sts, slip these 2 [2:2:3:3:4] sts onto a stitch holder for Neckband. 20 [23:25:27:29:31] sts.

Next row (WS): K to end.

Next row (RS): K to last 2 sts, K2tog, **Neck Edge.** 19 [22:24:26:28:30] sts.

Rep last 2 rows 3 [4:4:4:5:5] times more. 16 [18:20:22:23:25] sts.

Work 11 [13:13:13:15:15] rows without shaping.

Shape Shoulder

Next row (RS): Cast off 8 [9:10:11:11:12] sts, K to end. 8 [9:10:11:12:13] sts.

Next row: K to end.

Cast off rem 8 [9:10:11:12:13] sts.

Right Front

Using 3.25mm needles cast on 22 [25:27:30:32:35] sts.

Row 1 (RS): Neck Edge. K to end.

Row 2 (WS): K to end.

These 2 rows set garter stitch and are repeated.

Work 2 more rows in g-st.

Change to 4mm needles and cont in g-st (throughout) until Right Front measures 11 [14:17:18:21:23]cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Place markers at beg of last row to identify armhole.

Cont until Right Front measures 16 [19:23:27:28:31]cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Shape Neck

Next row (RS): K2 [2:2:3:3:4], slip these 2 [2:2:3:3:4] sts onto a stitch holder for Neckband, K to end. 20 [23:25:27:29:31] sts.

Next row (WS): K to end.

Next row (RS): Neck Edge. K2tog, K to end. 19 [22:24:26:28:30] sts.

Rep last 2 rows 3 [4:4:4:5:5] times more. 16 [18:20:22:23:25] sts.

Work 12 [14:14:14:16:16] rows without shaping.

Shape Shoulder

Next row (WS): Cast off 8 [9:10:11:11:12] sts, K to end. 8 [9:10:11:12:13] sts.

Next row: K to end.

Cast off rem 8 [9:10:11:12:13] sts.

Back

Using **3.25mm needles** cast on 49 [55:59:65:69:75] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K to end.

Row 2 (WS): K to end.

These 2 rows set garter stitch and are repeated.

Work 2 more rows in g-st.

Change to 4mm needles and cont in g-st (throughout) until Back measures 11 [14:17:18:21:23]cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Place markers at each end of last row to identify armholes.

Cont until Back measures 16 [19:23:27:28:31]cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Work 12 [16:16:16:20:20] rows more.

Shape Neck

Next row (RS): K18 [20:22:24:25:27], turn and leave rem 31 [35:37:41:44:48] sts on needle.

Work each side of neck separately.

Next row (WS): K to end.

Next row (RS): K to last 2 sts, K2tog, **Neck Edge**.

17 [19:21:23:24:26] sts.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 16 [18:20:22:23:25] sts.

Work 3 rows without shaping.

Shape Shoulder

Next row (RS): Cast off 8 [9:10:11:11:12] sts, K to end.

8 [9:10:11:12:13] sts.

Next row: K to end.

Cast off rem 8 [9:10:11:12:13] sts.

With **RS** facing and working on rem 31 [35:37:41:44:48] sts, slip first 13 [15:15:17:19:21] sts onto a stitch holder for Neckband, **rejoin yarn** to rem 18 [20:22:24:25:27] sts and K to end.

Next row (WS): K to end.

Next row (RS): **Neck Edge**. K2tog, K to end. 17 [19:21:23:24:26] sts.

Rep last 2 rows once more. 16 [18:20:22:23:25] sts.

Work 4 rows without shaping.

Shape Shoulder

Next row (WS): Cast off 8 [9:10:11:11:12] sts, K to end.

8 [9:10:11:12:13] sts.

Next row: K to end.

Cast off rem 8 [9:10:11:12:13] sts.

Sleeves (both alike)

Using **3.25mm needles**, cast on 28 [30:32:34:36:38] sts and work 4 rows in g-st as given for Back.

Change to 4mm needles and cont in g-st (throughout).

Work 4 rows without shaping.

Inc row (RS): Kfb, K to last 2 sts, Kfb, K1. 30 [32:34:36:38:40] sts

Work 7 [7:7:7:9:9] rows without shaping in g-st.

Rep last 8 [8:8:8:10:10] rows 4 [5:6:7:8:9] times more.

38 [42:46:50:54:58] sts.

Cont without shaping until Sleeve measures 12 [15:17:20:24:29]cm from cast on edge, ending with **RS** facing for next row.

Shape Sleeve Top

Cast off 5 [5:6:6:7:7] sts at beg of next 6 rows. 8 [12:10:14:12:16] sts.

Cast off rem 8 [12:10:14:12:16] sts.

Neckband

Join shoulder seams. With **RS** facing and using **3.25mm needles**, slip 2 [2:2:3:3:4] sts left on holder at right side of neck onto needle, using same needle pick up and K12 [14:14:14:18:18] sts evenly up right side of neck, 4 sts evenly down right side of back neck, K across 13 [15:15:17:19:21] sts left on holder at back of neck, pick up and K4 sts evenly up left side of neck, 12 [14:14:14:18:18] sts evenly down left side of neck and K across 2 [2:2:3:3:4] sts left on holder at left side of neck. 49 [55:55:59:69:73] sts.

Knit 4 rows.

Cast off knitwise.

Right Front Border

With **RS** facing and using **3.25mm needles**, beg at lower edge of Right Front, pick up and K34 [41:50:56:60:66] sts evenly up Right Front edge to Neckband and 3 sts evenly up Neckband. 37 [44:53:59:63:69] sts.

Knit 3 rows.

Buttonhole row 1 (RS): K23 [30:37:36:38:42], cast off 2 sts – 1 st left on RH needle, (K6 [6:8:6:7:8], cast off 2 sts – 1 st left on RH needle) 1 [1:1:2:2:2] times, K2.

Buttonhole row 2: K3, cast on 2 sts, (K7 [7:9:7:8:9], cast on 2 sts) 1 [1:1:2:2:2] times, K23 [30:37:36:38:42].

Knit 3 rows.

Cast off knitwise.

Left Front Border

With **RS** facing and using **3.25mm needles**, beg at neck edge of Left Front, pick up and knit 3 sts evenly down Neckband and 34 [41:50:56:60:66] sts evenly down Left Front edge. 37 [44:53:59:63:69] sts.

Knit 8 rows.

Cast off knitwise.

Making Up

Insert Sleeves by folding each sleeve in half lengthwise and place fold to shoulder seam, sew in position between markers. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons matching buttonholes.

Weave in ends and pin your garment out to size stated in the pattern, cover with a damp cloth and leave to dry.
