

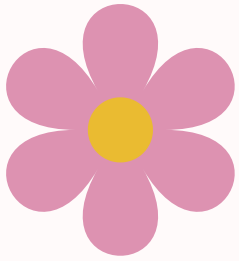

Tension

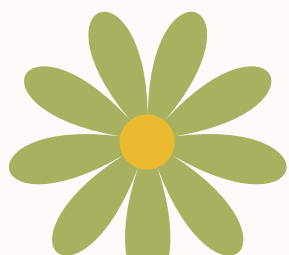
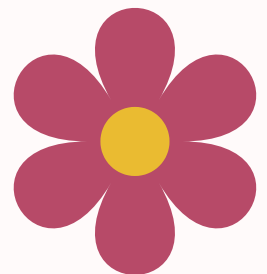
16 stitches x 11 rows (10.16cm, 4 ins square) with the half treble crochet stitch

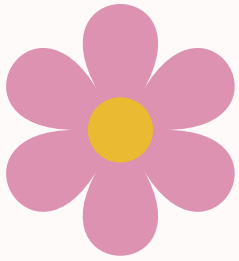
4.5mm Crochet Hook

Tapestry/Wool Needle



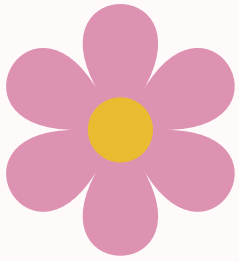

B - Petal Pink (3364)
C - Celery (3186)
D - Vintage Pink (3376)
E - Powder Blue (3262)
F - Apple Green (3188)
G - Lavender (3360)
H - Off White (3045)



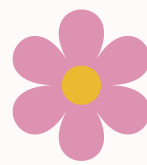

Option 1 - Yarnsmiths Pebble Haze DK - 50g

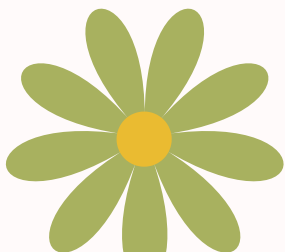
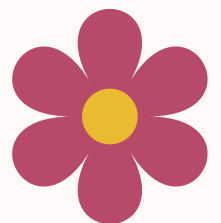
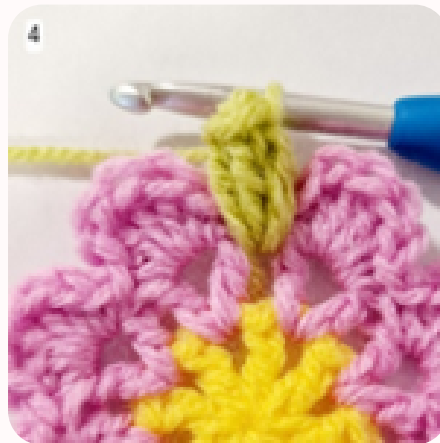
Shades
A – Yellow Topaz (2C114)
B – Petalite (2C200)
C – Titanite (2C120)
D – Pink Smithsonite (2C198)
E – Blue Beryl (2C164)
F – Olivine (2C130)
G – Iolite (2C180)
H – Limestone (2C050)





Special Stitches

Popcorn Stitch – 5 tr into same stitch, remove loop from hook and insert hook into first tr stitch of the 5 tr (see pic 1 below), slip loop back onto hook and pull through the first tr (see pics 2, 3 and 4 below).





Puff Stitch - *insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over; repeat from * 2 more times, 6 loops on the hook, yarn over and pull through all loops (see pics 1 to 5 below).





Butterfly Stitch –

All stitches worked in either blo or flo of same stitch.

Note - Your work will naturally rotate as you crochet the stitches in step 3, with the back of your panel facing you. This is fine, and you will end up with the right side facing you at the end of the butterfly.

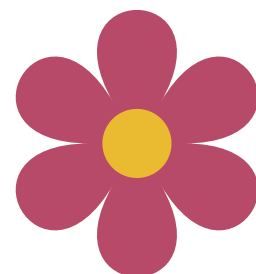
Step 1 - After changing colours, ss in blo of next stitch (see pics 1 and 2 below).

Step 2 - (ch3, 4tr, ch2, ss, ch1, 3htr, ch1, ss) all in blo of stitch (see pic 3 below).

Step 3 - Ss into flo of the same stitch (this can be tricky to find, see pics 4, 5 and 6 below).

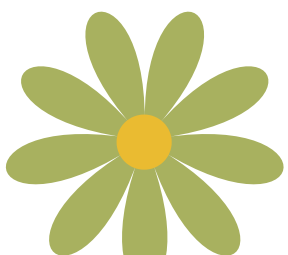
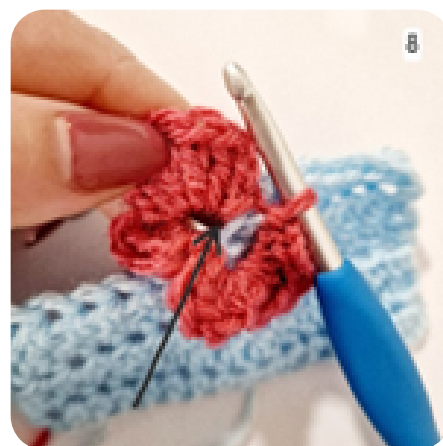
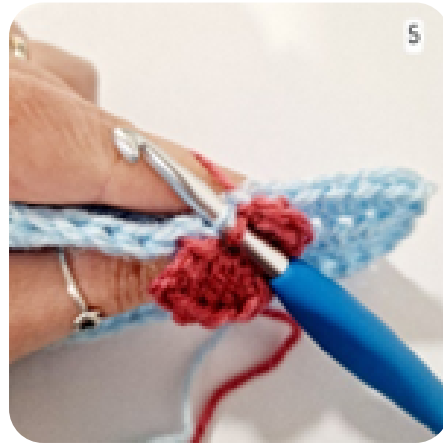
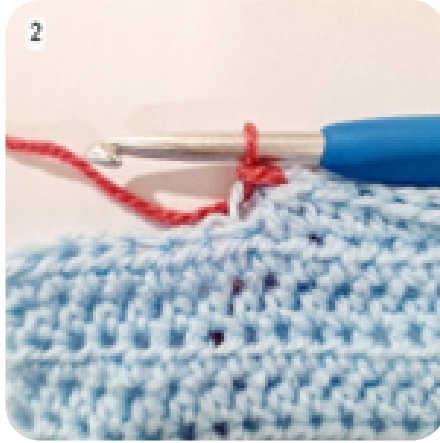
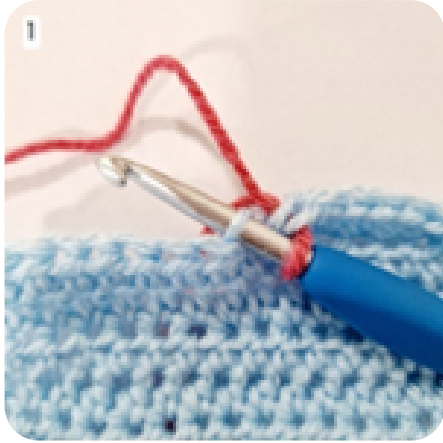
Step 4 - (ch1, 3htr, ch1, ss, ch2, 4tr, ch3, ss) all in flo of stitch (see pic 7 below).

Step 5 - Ss into blo where you placed your first ss (see pic 8 below).

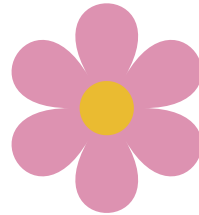




Butterfly Stitch –

Abbreviations UK Terms

MR – Magic Ring

CH – Chain

SS – Slip stitch

DC – Double crochet

HTR – Half treble crochet

TR – Treble crochet

HTR2TOG – Half treble crochet decrease stitch

V-ST – V Stitch

STS – Number of stitches

BLO – Back loop only

FLO – Front loop only

[] – Repeat as many times as stated

() – In same stitch

FO – Fasten Off

PM – Place marker

RS – Right side facing

WS – Wrong side facing
