## MATERIALS AND MEASUREMENTS

Yarnsmiths Chenille Chunky		
Yarn A	3	Balls
Yarn B	1	Ball
Yarn C	1	Ball
6 mm Crochet hook 16 inch round pillow insert Large eye yarn needle Scissors 3.5 inch Felt Eyes (can be found on Etsy) Stitch markers Hot glue gun

## ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

- Ch** - Chain stitch;
- Inc** - Increase;
- Sts** - Stitch/stitches;
- Dc** - Double crochet;
- Htc** - Half treble crochet;
- Dc3tog** - Double crochet two stitches together;
- FO** - Fasten off;
- Slst** - Slip stitch;
- MR** - Magic Ring;
- Tr** - Treble crochet;
- Dtr** - Double treble crochet;
- (-)** - All in the same stitch;
- \*.\*** Repeat to end of the row.

## PILLOW BASE

Using yarn A, Ch 2 and work your sts into the second Ch from the hook. Make 2.

- Round 1** - 7 Dc (7 sts)
  - Round 2** - Inc in each st around (14 sts)
  - Round 3** - \*Inc, 1 Dc\* (21 sts)
  - Round 4** - \*Inc, 2 Dc\* (28 sts)
  - Round 5** - \*3 Dc, Inc\* (35 sts)
  - Round 6** - \*2 Dc, Inc, 2 Dc\* (42 sts)
  - Round 7** - \*Inc, 5 Dc\* (49 sts)
  - Round 8** - \*3 Dc, Inc, 3 Dc\* (56 sts)
  - Round 9** - \*Inc, 7 Dc\* (63 sts)
  - Round 10** - \*4 Dc, Inc, 4 Dc\* (70 sts)
  - Round 11** - Inc, 9 Dc\* (77 sts)
  - Round 12** - \*5 Dc, Inc, 5 Dc\* (84 sts)
  - Round 13** - \*Inc, 11 Dc\* (91 sts)
  - Round 14** - 6 Dc, Inc, 6 Dc\* (98 sts)
  - Round 15** - \*Inc, 13 Dc\* (105 sts)
  - Round 16** - 7 Dc, Inc, 7 Dc\* (112 sts)
  - Round 17** - \*Inc, 15 Dc\* (119 sts)
  - Round 18** - 8 Dc, Inc, 8 Dc\* (126 sts)
  - Round 19** - \*Inc, 17 Dc\* (133 sts)
  - Round 20 to 22** - 1 Dc around (133 sts) (3 Rounds).
- Sew the two bases together, inserting the pillow and sewing the two sides around it. FO and weave in the ends.

## SNOUT

Using yarn B, Ch 13 and start Round 1 in the second Ch from the hook.

- Round 1** - 11 Dc, Inc x3.  
Rotate your crochet and continue to work the following stitches into the opposite side of the chain. 10 Dc, Inc x2. (26 sts)
- Round 2** - Inc, 10 Dc, Inc x3, 10 Dc, Inc x2 (32 sts)
- Round 3** - Inc, 11 Dc, \*Inc, 1 Dc\* x3, 10 Dc, \*Inc, 1 Dc\* x2. (38 sts)
- Round 4** - 2 Dc, Inc, 10 Dc, \*2 Dc, Inc\* x3, 10 Dc, \*2 Dc, Inc\* x2. (44 sts)

**Round 5** - Inc, 13 Dc, \*Inc, 3 Dc\* x3, 10 Dc, \*Inc, 3 Dc\* x2. (50 sts)

**Round 6** - 4 Dc, Inc, 10 Dc, \*4 Dc, Inc\* x3, 10 Dc, \*4 Dc, Inc\* x2. (56 sts)

**Round 7** - Inc, 15 Dc, \*Inc, 5 Dc\* x3, 10 Dc, \*Inc, 5 Dc\* x2. (62 sts)

**Round 8** - 1 Dc in each st around (62 sts)

FO leaving a long tail. Sew onto the pillow base just below the centre. Stuff as you go to ensure even distribution. Weave in the ends.

## SNOUT HORN

Using yarn C, Ch 2 and work your sts into the second Ch from the hook.

- Round 1** - 4 Dc (4 sts)
  - Round 2** - \*Inc, 1 Dc\* (6 sts)
  - Round 3** - 1 Dc in each st around (6 sts)
  - Round 4** - Inc, 2 Dc\* (8 sts)
  - Round 5** - 1 Dc in each st around (8 sts)
  - Round 6** - Inc, 3 Dc\* (10 sts)
  - Round 7** - 1 Dc in each st around (10 sts)
  - Round 8** - Inc, 4 Dc\* (12 sts)
  - Round 9** - 1 Dc in each st around (12 sts)
- FO leaving a long tail for sewing onto the pillow. Stuff and sew onto the pillow on the top, centre of the snout. Glue or sew the eyes into position, either side of the horn as pictured.

## FRILL

Using yarn A, Ch 71 and work your sts into the second Ch from the hook. Make 2.

- Round 1** - 1 Dc in each st across. Ch 1 and turn. (70 sts)
- Round 2** - 7 Dc, (3 Dc), 9 Dc, (3 Dc), 9 Dc, (3 Dc), 14 Dc, (3 Dc), 9 Dc, (3 Dc), 9 Dc, (3 Dc), 7 Dc. Ch 1 and turn. (82 sts)
- Round 3** - 8 Dc, (3 Dc), 11 Dc, (3 Dc), 11 Dc, (3 Dc), 16 Dc, (3 Dc), 11 Dc, (3 Dc), 11 Dc, (3 Dc), 8 Dc. Ch 1 and turn. (94 sts)

**Round 4** - 1 Dc, 1 Htc, 1 Tr, 3 Dtr,  
1 Tr, 1 htc, 1 Dc, Slst,  
1 Dc, 2 Htr, 2 Tr, 3 Dtr, 2 Tr, 2 Htr,  
1 Dc, Slst,  
1 Dc, 2 Htr, 2 Tr, 3 Dtr, 2 Tr, 2 Htr,  
1 Dc, Slst,  
2 Dc, 3 Htr, 3 Tr, 2 Dtr, 3 Tr, 3 Htr,  
2 Dc, Slst,  
1 Dc, 2 Htr, 2 Tr, 3 Dtr, 2 Tr, 2 Htr,  
1 Dc, Slst,  
1 Dc, 2 Htr, 2 Tr, 3 Dtr, 2 Tr, 2 Htr,  
1 Dc, Slst,  
1 Dc, 1 htc, 1 Tr, 3 Dtr, 1 Tr, 1 htc,  
1 Dc, Ch 1 and turn. (94 sts)

**Round 5** - 4 Dc, (3 Dc), 4 Dc, Slst,  
6 Dc, (3 Dc), 6 Dc, Slst,  
6 Dc, (3 Dc), 6 Dc, Slst,  
8 Dc, (3 Dc), 8 Dc, Slst,  
6 Dc, (3 Dc), 6 Dc, Slst,  
6 Dc, (3 Dc), 6 Dc, Slst,  
4 Dc, (3 Dc), 4 Dc. (108 sts)

FO and leave a long tail for sewing  
up. Put the two frill panels together  
and work the next row through  
both to connect them.

**Round 6** - 5 Dc, (3 Dc), 5 Dc, Slst,  
7 Dc, (3 Dc), 7 Dc, Slst,  
7 Dc, (3 Dc), 7 Dc, Slst,  
10 Dc, (3 Dc), 10 Dc, Slst,  
7 Dc, (3 Dc), 7 Dc, Slst,  
7 Dc, (3 Dc), 7 Dc, Slst,  
5 Dc, (3 Dc), 5 Dc. (123 sts)

FO leaving a long tail. Sew the open  
edges of the frill together with a  
whip stitch. Do not stuff.

## **HEAD HORNS (Make 2)**

Using yarn C, make a MR.

**Round 1** - 4 Dc (4 sts)

**Round 2** - \*Inc, 1 Dc\* (6 sts)

**Round 3** - 1 Sc in each st around  
(6 sts)

**Round 4** - Inc, 2 Dc\* (8 sts)

**Round 5** - 1 Sc in each st around  
(8 sts)

**Round 6** - Inc, 3 Dc\* (10 sts)

**Round 7** - 1 Sc in each st around  
(10 sts)

**Round 8** - Inc, 4 Dc\* (12 sts)

**Round 9** - 1 Sc in each st around  
(12 sts)

**Round 10** - Inc, 5 Dc\* (14 sts)

**Round 11** - 1 Sc in each st around  
(14 sts)

**Round 12** - Inc, 6 Dc\* (16 sts)

**Round 13** - Inc, 7 Dc\* (18 sts)

FO leaving a long tail to sew onto  
the pillow. Stuff lightly. Sew onto  
the pillow directly in front of the  
frill, matching them up with the eye  
placement.

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
