Welcome to Week Four of the Spring in Bloom CAL by Emkat Crochet. This week we will be focusing on making flower squares 9 and 10, as well as the tulip panel 3 and butterfly panel 3. Special stitches will include Popcorn stitch, Puff stitch, and Butterfly stitch



Puff Stitch - *insert hook, yarn over, pull through, yarn over; repeat from* 2 more times, 6 loops on the hook, yarn over, pull through all loops

Popcorn Stitch – 5 tr into same stitch, remove loop from hook and insert hook into first tr stitch of the 5 tr, slip loop back onto hook and pull through the first tr

Butterfly Stitch –

All stitches worked in either blo or flo of same stitch.

Note - Your work will naturally rotate with you doing step 3's set of stitches with the back of your panel facing you, this is fine, and you will end up with the right side facing at the end of the butterfly.

Step 1 - After changing colours, ss in blo of next stitch

Step 2 - (ch3, 4tr, ch2, ss, ch1, 3htr, ch1, ss) all in blo of stitch

Step 3 - Ss into flo of the same stitch

Step 4 - (ch1, 3htr, ch1, ss, ch2, 4tr, ch3, ss) all in flo of stitch

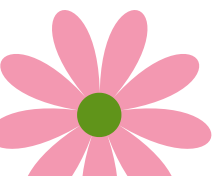
Step 5 - Ss into blo where you did your first ss





Pattern notes:

- Pattern is written in UK Terms
- Ch1 at the beginning of each row **DOES NOT** count as a stitch
- Tulip and Butterfly panels worked in rows
- Flower squares are made in the round without turning **UNLESS** otherwise stated
- Special stitches used this week – **Popcorn stitch, Puff stitch and Butterfly stitch**
- Bordering your panels worked in the round
- Turn at the end of each row
- If you're using your own colours, please see flower colour chart for guidance on colours used for each flower (there will be one in each week we are doing flowers)
- Lightly block your panels when completed. They should measure 22cm x 22cm for the flower squares and 88cm x 22cm for the tulip and butterfly panels
- Keep a note of what number your squares and panels are, **this is needed for joining**
- Please follow the **colour chart** for **Week 4** Flowers





Pattern Information:

Tulip Panel 3

To start –

To start, in **Yarn C**, chain 131

Row 1 (WS): Working in the 2nd chain from the hook, htr across, turn (130 sts)

Row 2 (RS): Ch1, 130htr, turn (130 sts)

Row 3 (WS): Ch1, 1tr, skip 1, 1v-st, skip 1, *1v-st, skip 2; repeat from * to the last 3 stitches, 1v-st, skip 1, 1tr (43 v-sts, 88 tr sts, 43 ch1 spaces)

FO **Yarn C**, attach **Yarn B**



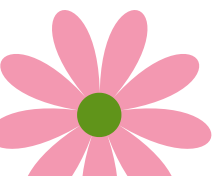
Row 4 (RS): Ch1, 1tr, ch1, *popcorn, ch2; repeat from * to the last 4 sts, popcorn, skip 1, 1tr (43 popcorn, 2trs, 42 ch2 spaces, 1 ch1 space)

FO **Yarn B**, attach **Yarn E**

Row 5 (WS): Ch1, htr in first st, htr in top of first popcorn, *2htr in ch2 space, 1 htr in popcorn; repeat from * to last 2 sts, 1 htr in ch1 space, 1 htr in last stitch (130 sts)

Row 6 (RS): Ch1, 130htr, turn (130 sts)

FO **Yarn E**, attach **Yarn C**





Tulip Panel 3 Continued

Row 7 (WS): Ch1, 130htr, turn (130 sts)

Rows 8 – 13: Repeat rows 2 – 7

Rows 14 – 18: Repeat rows 2 – 6

Now you will be bordering your panel

FO **Yarn E**, attach **Yarn C** right side facing to the top right corner stitch

Round 1: Ch1, *129tr to the last stitch, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in last stitch, 30tr evenly down the side of your panel to the last stitch, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in last stitch; repeat from * 1 more time, ss to first stitch (334 sts, 4 ch2 spaces)

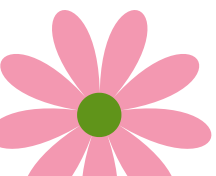


FO **Yarn C**, attach **Yarn H** in any chain 2 space

Round 2: Ch1, *(1htr, ch1, 1htr) in chain 2 space, htr across to chain 2 space; repeat from * 3 more times, ss to first stitch (342 sts, 4 ch1 spaces)

Fasten off and sew in all ends

Now make a start on Butterfly panel 3!





Butterfly Panel 3

To Start –

To Start, in **Yarn C**, chain 131

Row 1 (RS): Working in the 2nd chain from the hook, *1dc, 1tr; repeat from * working in each chain to the end, ending with a tr stitch, turn (130 sts)

Row 2 (WS): Ch1, *1dc, 1tr; repeat from * working in each chain to the end, ending with a tr stitch, turn (130 sts)

Row 3 (RS): Rows 3 – 7: Repeat row 2

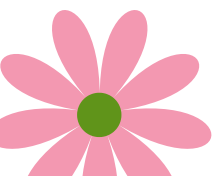
FO **Yarn C**, attach **Yarn E**

Row 8 (WS): Ch1, 130htr, turn (130 sts)

Rows 9 – 12: Repeat row 8



Row 13 (RS) SAME METHOD AS WEEK 2: Ch1, 6htr, changing to **Yarn A** on the 6th stitch, *1 butterfly, change back to **Yarn E**, FO **Yarn A**, 12htr, changing to **Yarn A** on the 12th stitch; repeat from * 8 more times, 1 butterfly, change back to **Yarn E**, 6htr, turn (10 butterflies, 120 sts)

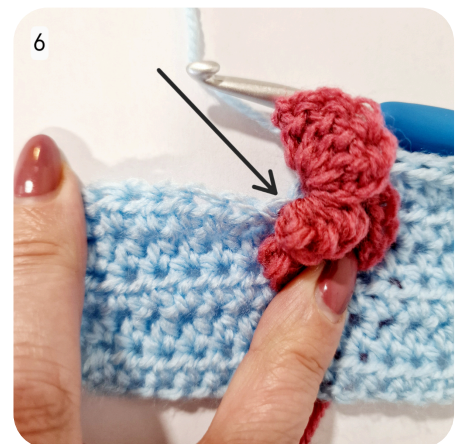
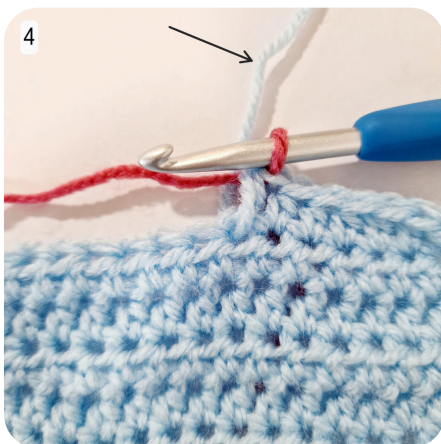
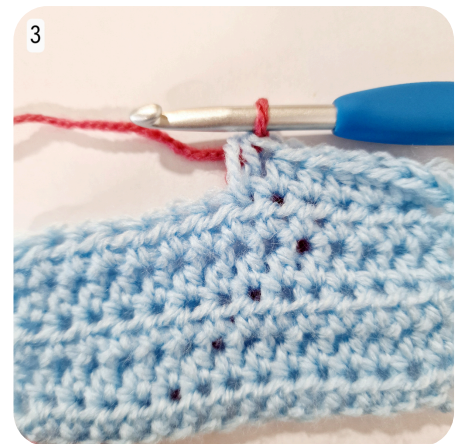
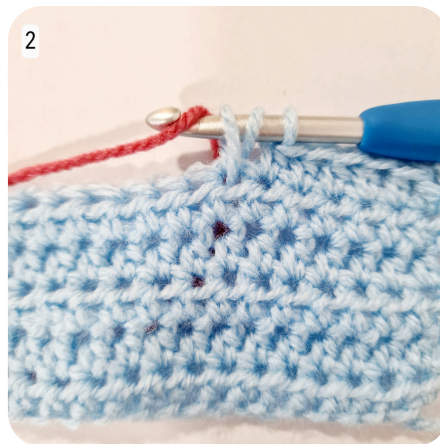
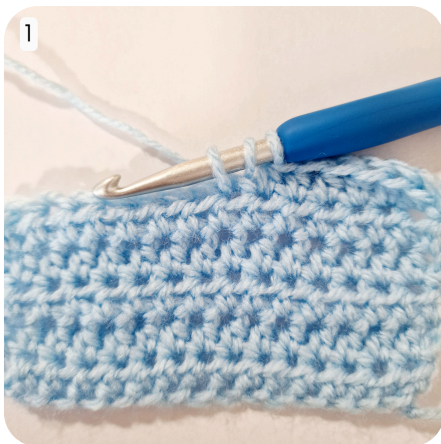




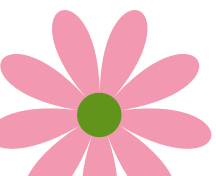
Butterfly Panel 3 continued

Butterfly Instructions and changing colours

Before finishing your 6th or 12th stitch, don't pull through **Yarn E**, but instead join your new colour **Yarn A** and pull through (see pics 1, 2 and 3 below) (leaving **Yarn E** still attached at the back of your work, see pic 4 below). Then, after your butterfly, change back to **Yarn E** (by picking it up from the back of your work see pic 5 below), then fasten off **Yarn A**, then see pic 6 below of first htr placement after your butterfly

Butterfly Panel 3 continued

Row 14 (WS): Ch1, 6dc, *ch1, 12 dc; repeat from * to last 7 stitches, ch1, 6dc, turn (120 sts, 10 ch1 spaces)

Row 15 (RS): Ch1, 130htr (make sure you do a htr over chain 1 spaces from previous row, see pic 1 below), turn (65 sts)

Row 16 (WS): Ch1, 130 htr, turn (130 sts)

Rows 17 – 18: Repeat row 16

Row 19 (RS): Ch1, 12htr, change to Yarn A (leaving Yarn E still attached at the back of your work), *1 butterfly, change back to Yarn E (by picking it up from the back of your work, FO Yarn A) 12htr; repeat from * to the last stitch, 1htr, turn (9 butterflies, 121 sts)

Row 20 (WS): Ch1, 13dc, *ch1, 12 dc; repeat from * to the end, turn (121 sts, 9 ch1 spaces)





Butterfly Panel 3 continued

Row 21: Repeat row 15

Rows 22 – 24: Repeat row 16

Now you will be bordering your panel.

FO **Yarn E**, attach **Yarn C** right side facing to the top right corner stitch.

Round 1: Ch1, *129tr to the last stitch, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in last stitch, 30tr evenly down the side of your panel to the last stitch, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in last stitch; repeat from * 1 more time, ss to first stitch (334 sts, 4 ch2 spaces)

FO **Yarn C**, attach **Yarn H** in any chain 2 space.

Round 2: Ch1, *(1htr, ch1, 1htr) in chain 2 space, htr across to chain 2 space; repeat from * 3 more times, ss to first stitch (342 sts, 4 ch1 spaces)

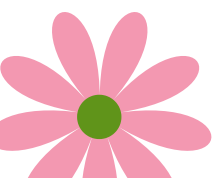
Fasten off and sew in all ends



Adding detail to your butterflies – Same method as week 2 in **Yarn G**.

Fasten off and sew in all ends

Now start on flower squares 9 and 10!





Pattern Information:

To Start –

Make a MR in **Yarn A**

Round 1: Ch1, [1tr, ch 1] x8, ss into top of first tr (8 sts, 8 ch1 spaces)

FO **Yarn A**, attach **Yarn B** in any chain 1 space

Round 2: Ch1, [1 v-st in chain 1 space] x8, ss into top of first tr (16 sts, 8 ch1 spaces)

Round 3: Ch1, [(1dc, 1htr, 3tr, 1htr, 1dc) in chain 1 space] x8, ss (56 sts)

FO **Yarn B**, attach **Yarn F** in space as per picture 1 below

Round 4: [(Ch1, 1 popcorn in space where you joined (see pic above), ch4, ss in next space (see picture 1 below for placement)] x8, ss into back of first popcorn (8 popcorn, 8 ch4 spaces)

FO **Yarn F**, attach **Yarn E** in any chain 4 space

Round 5: Ch1, [(1dc, 1htr, 3tr, 1htr, 1dc) over chain 4] x8, ss (56 sts)

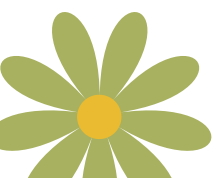
FO **Yarn E**, attach **Yarn F** in space behind round 4 (see picture below)

Round 6: [(ch1, 1 popcorn, ch1, 1 popcorn, ch5, ss)] x8, ss into back of first popcorn (16 popcorn, 8 ch1 spaces, 8 ch5 spaces)

FO **Yarn F**, attach **Yarn D** in any chain 5 space





Round 7: Ch1, [(1dc, 1htr, 5tr, 1htr, 1dc, ch1) over chain 5] x8, ss (72 sts, 8 ch1 spaces)

FO **Yarn D**, attach **Yarn F** in any chain 1 space

Round 8: [(Ch1, 1 popcorn, ch6, ss) in chain 1 space] x8, ss into back of first popcorn (8 popcorn, 8 ch6 spaces)

FO **Yarn F**, attach **Yarn G** in any chain 6 space

Round 9: Ch1, [(1dc, 1htr, 7tr, 1htr, 1dc, ch1) over chain 6] x8, ss (88 sts, 8 ch1 spaces)

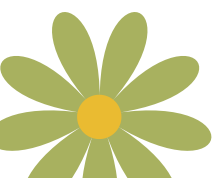
FO **Yarn G**, attach **Yarn B** in any chain 1 space

We are now going to begin squaring off your flowers, please note you will need to **TURN** after rounds 10 and 11

Round 10: Ch1, (2tr) in chain 1 space, *skip 1, BLO 2htr, 6dc, 2htr, 1tr (over chain 1 space), skip 1, BLO 2htr, 6dc, 2htr, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) over chain 1 space; repeat from * 2 more times, skip 1, BLO 2htr, 6dc, 2htr, 1tr (over chain 1 space), skip 1, BLO 2htr, 6dc, 2htr, (2tr, ch2), ss to first stitch, **TURN** (100 sts, 4 ch2 spaces)

Round 11: Ss into chain 2 space, ch1, 1tr in chain 2 space, *2tr, 2htr, 17dc, 2htr, 2tr, (1tr, ch2, 1tr) in chain 2 space; repeat from * 2 more times, 2tr, 2htr, 17dc, 2htr, 2tr, (1tr, ch2) in chain 2 space, ss to first stitch, **TURN** (108 sts, 4 ch2 spaces)

FO **Yarn B**, attach **Yarn C** in any chain 2 space





Round 12: Ch1, 1htr in chain 2 space, *[skip 1, ch1, 1htr] x13, skip 1, ch1, (1htr, ch2, 1htr) in chain 2 space; repeat from * 2 more times, [skip 1, ch1, 1htr] x13, skip 1, ch1, (1htr, ch2) in chain 2 space, ss to first stitch (60 sts, 14 ch1 spaces, 4 ch2 spaces)

DO NOT TURN

FO **Yarn C**, attach **Yarn A** in any chain 2 space

Round 13: Ch1, 1puff in chain 2 space, *[ch1, 1puff in chain 1 space] x14, ch1, (1puff, ch2, 1puff) in chain 2 space; repeat from * 2 more times, [ch1, 1puff in chain 1 space] x14, ch1, (1puff, ch2) in chain 2 space, ss to first stitch (64 puff sts, 4 ch2 spaces)

FO **Yarn A**, attach **Yarn E** in any chain 2 space

Round 14: Ch1, (2tr) in chain 2 space, *[2tr in chain 1 space] x15, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in chain 2 space; repeat from * 2 more times, [2tr in chain 1 space] x15, (2tr, ch2) in chain 2 space, ss to first stitch (136 sts, 4 ch2 spaces)

FO **Yarn E**, attach **Yarn H** in any chain 2 space

Round 15: Ch1, *(1htr, ch1, 1htr) in chain 2 space, htr across to chain 2 space; repeat from * 3 more times, ss to first stitch (144 sts, 4 ch1 spaces)

Fasten off and sew in all ends





Repeat rounds 1 – 15 for flower 10. Please use the chart below, which indicates which yarn to use for which round
