MATERIALS AND MEASUREMENTS

Yarnsmiths Cotton DK		
Yarn A	I	Ball
Yarn B	I	Ball
Yarn C	I	Ball
Yarn D	I	Ball
Yarn E	I	Ball
Yarn F	I	Ball
2.5mm hook Black embroidery Floss Fibrefill 2 x 6mm safety eyes Yarn needle

The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. Please note that the limitations of the printing process mean the actual colour will not always precisely match the colours shown in the photograph.

NOTES

Depending on your tension you may have to adjust the positioning of the arms so they're in line with the legs. Slip stitches and chains do not count as stitches throughout.

ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

MR - Magic ring;
Ch - Chain stitch;
Dc - Double crochet;
Tr - Treble crochet;
Inc - Increase;
Dec - Decrease;
DcInc - Two Dc in same st;
FLO - Front loop only;
Htr - Half treble crochet;
Sk - Skip;
Slst - Slip stitch;
st(s) - Stitch(es);
RS - Right side;
WS - Wrong side;
* - Repeat the instructions between the asterisk as directed;
() - Stitch count.

ARMS (make two)

Using yarn A:

Round 1 - 8Dc in MR (8).

Round 2 to 12 - Dc each st around (8) *11 rounds*.

Round 13 - Do not stuff, fold arm flat and working through both sides at the same time, Dc across (4).

Finish off and weave in ends.

MUZZLE

Using yarn B:

Round 1 - 6Dc in MR (6).

Round 2 - Inc each st around, Slst to beginning st to join (12).

Finish off leaving a long tail.

Use embroidery floss to add a nose.

Tie loose ends together to secure.

LEG ONE

Using yarn A:

Round 1 - 6Dc in MR (6).

Round 2 - Inc each st around (12).

Rounds 3 to 11 - Dc each st around (12) *9 rounds*.

Finish off and weave in ends.

LEG TWO

Repeat leg one but do not finish off, we will now begin the body.

BODY

Round 12 - With leg two still on your hook, Ch3, 12Dc around leg one, 3Dc in Ch3, 12Dc around leg two, 3Dc in other side of Ch3 (30).

Round 13 - *2Dc, Inc, 2Dc* repeat 6 times (36).

Round 14 - *5Dc, Inc* repeat 6 times (42).

Rounds 15 to 18 - Dc each st around (42) *4 rounds*.

Round 19 - *5Dc, Dec* repeat 6 times (36).

Rounds 20 to 21 - Dc each st around (36) *2 rounds*.

Round 22 - *2Dc, Dec, 2Dc* repeat 6 times (30).

Round 23 - Dc each st around (30).

Round 24 - 6Dc, working through both arm one and body at the same time, 4Dc, 11Dc, working through both arm two and body at the same time, 4Dc, 5Dc (30).

Start stuffing the legs and body and continue as you go.

Round 25 - *3Dc, Dec* repeat 6 times (24).

Round 26 - *Dc, Dec, Dc* repeat 6 times (18).

HEAD

Round 27 - Inc each st around (36).

Round 28 - *5Dc, Inc* repeat 6 times (42).

Rounds 29 to 36 - Dc each st around (42) *8 rounds*.

Insert safety eyes between rounds 32 to 33 seven sts apart. Using the long tail, sew the muzzle between the eyes. Use yarn D to make two sts under each eye as cheeks.

Tie loose ends together to secure.

Round 37 - *5Dc, Dec* repeat 6 times (36).

Round 38 - *2Dc, Dec, 2Dc* repeat 6 times (30).

Round 39 - *3Dc, Dec* repeat 6 times (24).

Round 40 - *Dc, Dec, Dc* repeat 6 times (18).

Round 41 - *Sc, Dec* repeat 6 times (12).

Round 42 - Dc each st around (12). Finish off leaving a long tail, insert final amount of stuffing, weave tail through FLO of remaining 12 sts and pull tight to close. Weave in ends.

EARS (make two)

Using yarn A:

Round 1 - 6Dc in MR (6).

Round 2 - Inc each st (12).

Rounds 3 to 5 - Dc each st around (12) 3 rounds.

Round 6 - Do not stuff, fold ear flat and working through both sides at the same time, Dc across (6). Finish off leaving a long tail.

Attach to either side of the head over rounds 35 to 39.

Weave in ends.

DUNGAREES

Using yarn C:

Shorts

Leg one:

Round 1 - Ch20, Dc in first Ch to form a loop, careful not to twist your Ch, Dc each st around (20).

Rounds 2 to 3 - Dc each st around (20) 2 rounds.

Finish off and weave in ends.

Leg two:

Repeat leg one but do not fasten off.

Round 4 - With leg two still on your hook, Ch2, 20Dc around leg one, 2Dc in Ch2, 20Dc around leg two, 2Dc in other side of Ch2 (44).

Rounds 5 to 10 - Dc each st around (44) 6 rounds.

Round 11 - Dc each st around, Slst to beginning st to join (44).

Finish off and weave in ends.

Bib

Row 1 - Join yarn to 18th st of round 11, 10Dc, Ch1, turn (10).

Rows 2 to 6 - Dc each st across, Ch1, turn (10) 5 rows.

Row 7 - Dc each st along (10). Finish off and weave in ends.

Straps

Slst to first st of round 7, Ch10, join to back of dungarees with a Slst. Finish off and weave in ends.

Repeat for other side starting in final st of row 7.

HEART

Using yarn D:

Round 1 - Working in a MR, Ch3, Tr, 2Htr, Dc, Ch, Dc, 2Htr, Tr, Ch3, Slst.

Finish off, pull MR tight leaving a long tail. Use long tail to sew heart to centre of bib.

TOP

Using yarn E:

Row 1 - (RS) Ch31, starting in 2nd Ch from hook, Dc each st along, Ch1, turn (30).

Row 2 - (WS) *2Dc, Inc, 2Dc* repeat 6 times, Ch1, turn (36).

Row 3 - *5Dc, Inc* repeat 6 times, Ch1, turn (42).

Row 4 - *3Dc, Inc, 3Dc* repeat 6 times, Ch1, turn (48).

Row 5 - *7Dc, Inc* repeat 6 times (54).

Do not turn. We will now start working in rounds.

Round 6 - Starting in the first st of row 5, 7Dc, Ch6, Sk12, 16Dc, Ch6, Sk12, 7Dc (42).

Round 7 - 7Dc, 6Dc in Ch6, 16Dc, 6Dc in Ch6, 7Dc (42).

Round 8 - Dc each st around, Slst to beginning st to join (42).

Finish off and weave in ends.

Top Ties

Using yarn E, Slst to first st of row 1, Ch15. Finish off and weave in ends.

Repeat in final st of row 1.

HEAD SCARF

Using yarn D:

Row 1 - Ch73, starting in 2nd Ch from hook, 2Slst, 5Dc, 10Htr, 38Tr, 10Htr, 5Dc, 2Slst (72).

Finish off, weave in ends. Tie scarf around head using a double knot.

TENNIS SKIRT

Using yarn F:

Round 1 - Ch42, Dc in first Ch to form a loop being careful not to twist your Ch, Dc each st around (42).

Rounds 2 to 4 - Dc each st around (42) 3 rounds.

Round 5 - Slst, Ch3, starting in same st as Slst, *Tr, DcInc* repeat 21 times, Slst to top of Ch3 (63).

Finish off and weave in ends.
