ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

K - Knit;

TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to make 10 cm,
4 ins in pattern on 4 mm needles.

LACE PANEL

Optional (count as 17 sts throughout)

Row 1 - [P1, K3] twice, Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Pssso, K2, P1, K3, P1.

Row 2 - K1, P3, K1, P7, K1, P3, K1.

Row 3 - P1, Sl 1, K2, Pssso the K2, P1, K2, [Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Pssso] twice, K1, P1, Sl 1, K2, Pssso the K2, P1.

Row 4 - K1, P1, Yrn, P1, K1, P7, K1, P1, Yrn, P1, K1.

Row 5 - P1, K3, P1, K1, [Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Pssso] 3 times, P1, K3, P1.

Row 6 - K1, P3, K1, P7, K1, P3, K1.

Row 7 - P1, Sl 1, K2, Pssso the K2, P1, K2, [Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Pssso] twice, K1, P1, Sl 1, K2, Pssso the K2, P1.

Row 8 - K1, P1, Yrn, P1, K1, P7, K1, P1, Yrn, P1, K1.

Row 9 - [P1, K3] twice, Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Pssso, K2, P1, K3, P1.

Row 10 - K1, P3, K1, P7, K1, P3, K1.

Row 11 - P1, Sl 1, K2, Pssso the K2, P1, K7, P1, Sl 1, K2, Pssso the K2, P1.

Row 12 - K1, P1, Yrn, P1, K1, P7, K1, P1, Yrn, P1, K1.

These 12 rows form lace panel.

ROUND NECK CARDIGAN

Instructions are given for Cardigan with lace panels. For Plain Cardigan work in Stst throughout, omitting lace panels.

BACK

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 43 (51, 57, 63, 69) sts.

Row 1 - K1, * P1, K1, repeat from * to end.

Row 2 - P1, * K1, P1, repeat from * to end.

Repeat the last 2 rows 4 (4, 4, 5, 5) times more.

Change to 4mm needles and work in Stst, starting knit, until Back measures 11 (13, 15, 17, 20) cm 4.25 (5, 6, 6 3/4, 7 3/4) ins, ending with a P row.

SHAPE RAGLAN

ARMHOLES

Cast off 2 sts at beginning of next 2 rows.

Work 2 (0, 2, 2, 2) rows straight.

Next row - K1, Sl 1, K1, Pssso, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Next row - P.

Repeat the last 2 rows until 19 (21, 23, 23, 25) sts remain, ending with the P row.

Next row - K1, Sl 1, K2tog, Pssso, K to last 4 sts, K3tog, K1.

Next row - P.

Slip remaining 15 (17, 19, 19, 21) sts on a holder.

SLEEVES (make 2)

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 29 (31, 33, 35, 37) sts and work 10 (10, 10, 12, 12) rows in rib as given for Back.

Change to 4mm needles.

Row 1 - K6 (7, 8, 9, 10), work 1st row of lace panel across next 17 sts, K6 (7, 8, 9, 10).

Row 2 - P6 (7, 8, 9, 10), work 2nd row of lace panel, P6 (7, 8, 9, 10). These 2 rows form Stst at either side of lace panel.

Keeping continuity of 12 rows of lace panel correct throughout, Inc 1 st at each end of next and every following 2nd (2nd, 2nd, 2nd, 4th) row until there are 37 (39, 37, 39, 51) sts, then every following 4 (4, 4, 4, 6)th row until there are 41 (45, 49, 53, 57) sts.

Work straight until Sleeve measures 10 (13, 16, 19, 22) cm 4 (5, 6 1/2, 7 1/2, 8 1/2) ins, ending with a WS row.

SHAPE RAGLAN TOP

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Row 3 - K1, sl 1, K1, pssso, work to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Row 4 - P2, work to last 2 sts, P2. Repeat the last 2 rows until 19 (19, 15, 11, 11) sts rem, ending with a WS row.

Next row - K1, sl 1, K2tog, pssso, work to last 4 sts, K3tog, K1.

Next row - P2, work to last 2 sts, P2.

Repeat the last 2 rows 2 (2, 1, 0, 0) times more.

Slip rem 7 sts onto a holder.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 19 (23, 27, 29, 33) sts and work 10 (10, 10, 12, 12) rows in rib as given for Back.

Change to 4mm needles and commence pattern.

Row 1 - K1 (5, 9, 11, 15), work 1st row of lace panel across next 17 sts, K1.

Row 2 - P1, work 2nd row of lace panel, P1 (5, 9, 11, 15).

These 2 rows form Stst at either side of lace panel.

Keeping continuity of 12 rows of lace panel correct throughout, continue until Front measures same as Back to start of raglan shaping, ending with a WS row (work 1 row more here for Right Front).

SHAPE RAGLAN

ARMHOLE

Keeping pattern correct cast off 2 sts at beginning of next row. **##** Work 3 (1, 3, 3, 3) rows straight.

Next row - K1, Sl 1, K1, Pssso, pattern to end.

Next row - Pattern to last 2 sts, P2.

Repeat the last 2 rows until 10 (12, 14, 14, 16) sts remain, ending at front edge.

SHAPE NECK

Next row - Pattern 1 (1, 3, 1, 3), slip these sts onto a safety pin, pattern to end.

Continue to dec 1 st at raglan edge on RS rows as before, at the same time, dec 1 st at neck edge on next 3 rows, then following 0 (1, 1, 2, 2) alternate rows. 4 sts remain.

Work 1 more raglan dec ending with the WS row. **###**

Next row - K1, Sl 1, K1, Pssso.

Next row - P2tog and fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 19 (23, 27, 29, 33) sts and work 10 (10, 10, 12, 12) rows in rib as given for Back.

Change to 4mm needles and commence pattern.

Row 1 - K1, work 1st row of lace panel across next 17 sts, K1 (5, 9, 11, 15).

Row 2 - P1 (5, 9, 11, 15), work 2nd row of lace panel, P1.

Work as given for Left Front from **##** to **##** working 1 row more where indicated.

Work 2 (0, 2, 2, 2) rows straight.

Next row - Pattern to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Next row - P2, pattern to end.

Repeat the last 2 rows until 10 (12, 14, 14, 16) sts remain, ending at front edge.

SHAPE NECK

Next row - Pattern 1 (1, 3, 1, 3) sts, slip these sts onto a safety pin, pattern to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1.

Work as given for Left Front from **###** to **###**.

Next row - K2tog, P1.

Next row - P2tog and fasten off.

MAKING UP

BUTTON BAND

Using 3.25 mm needles cast on 7 sts. Work in rib as given for Back until band, when slightly stretched, fits

up left front edge for a girl or right front edge for a boy to start of neck shaping, ending with a WS row for a girl or a RS row for a boy and sewing in place as you go along. Break yarn and slip sts onto a safety pin.

Mark positions on band for 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) buttons, the first 1 cm (.5 inch) above cast on edge and allowing for the last button to be placed 1 cm (.5 inch) above sts on safety pin.

Space remainder evenly between.

BUTTONHOLE BAND

Work as given for button band at the same time making buttonholes to match markers on RS rows as follows:

Rib 3, Yfwd, K2tog, rib 2.

Join raglan seams.

NECKBAND

Using 3.25mm needles, continue on from sts of right front band, knit across 1 (1, 3, 1, 3) sts on safety pin at right front neck, pick up and K10 (10, 10, 12, 12) sts up right front slope, knit across 7 sts of right sleeve top, 15 (17, 19, 19, 21) sts at back neck and 7 sts of left sleeve top, pick up and K10 (10, 10, 12, 12) sts down left front slope, knit across

1 (1, 3, 1, 3) sts on safety pin at left front neck then rib across 7 sts of left front band. 65 (67, 73, 73, 79) sts. Starting with a 2nd row work 7 rows in rib, making buttonhole as before to the 4th row.

Cast off in rib.

Join side and sleeve seams.

Sew on buttons.

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
