IMPORTANT

Use only the Yarnsmiths yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect item if any other brand is used. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate. Please note that the limitations of the printing process mean the actual colour will not always precisely match the colours shown in the photograph.

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10cm/4in square over st st using 4mm needles.

NOTES

When working from Chart, right side rows are k rows and read from right to left. Wrong side rows are p rows and read from left to right. Use small amounts of yarn for each area of colour, twist yarns on WS of work to avoid a hole.

ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

dec - decrease;
inc - increase;
k - knit;
ml - make one st by picking up and working into back of loop lying between st just worked and next st;
p - purl;
patt - pattern;
st(s) - stitch(es);
skpo - slip one, knit one, pass slipped st over;
st st - stocking stitch,
tog - together;
RS - right side;
WS - wrong side.

JUMPER

BACK

Both Versions

With 3.75mm needles and A cast on 66(74:82:90:102) sts.

Rib row 1 - K2, [p2, k2] to end.

Rib row 2 - P2, [k2, p2] to end.

These 2 rows form the rib.

Work a further 8(8:10:10:12) rows, inc 0(0:2:2:0) sts across last row. 66(74:84:92:102) sts.

Change to 4mm needles.

Fish with Bubbles only

Beg with a k row work 4 rows in st st.

Work in patt from Chart 1(1:2:3:3).

Row 1 - K6(8:10:6:9)A, [k14(14:16:20:20) sts of row 1 of chart 1(1:2:3:3), k6(8:8:10:12)A] twice, k14(14:16:20:20) sts of row 1 of chart 1(1:2:3:3), k6(8:10:6:9)A.

Row 2 - P6(8:10:6:9)A, [p14(14:16:20:20) sts of row 2 of chart 1(1:2:3:3), p6(8:8:10:12)A] twice, p14(14:16:20:20) sts of row 2 of chart 1(1:2:3:3), p6(8:10:6:9)A.

These 2 rows **set** the Charts.

Work in patt to end of row 11(11:13:15:15).

Using A, beg with a p row work in st st until Back measures 13(17:21:25:29)cm from cast on edge, ending with a p row.

Plain Fish only

Beg with a k row work 4 rows C and 4 rows A in st st.

Work in patt from Chart 1(1:2:3:3).

Row 1 - K6(8:10:6:9)A,
[k14(14:16:20:20) sts of row 1 of
chart 1(1:2:3:3), k6(8:8:10:12)A]
twice, k14(14:16:20:20) sts of row 1
of chart 1(1:2:3:3), k6(8:10:6:9)A.

Row 2 - P6(8:10:6:9)A,
[p14(14:16:20:20) sts of row 2 of
chart 1(1:2:3:3), p6(8:8:10:12)A]
twice, p14(14:16:20:20) sts of row 2
of chart 1(1:2:3:3), p6(8:10:6:9)A.
These 2 rows **set** the Charts.

Work in patt to end of row
11(11:13:15:15).

Beg with a p row work 5 rows A
and 4 rows C, in st st.

Both Versions

Work in main stripe patt.

Row 1 - Using 4mm needles and A,
k to end.

Row 2 - Using 4mm needles and A,
p to end.

Rows 3 to 8 - Rep rows 1 and 2
three times.

Rows 9 to 14 - Using 3.75mm
needles and B k to end.

Rows 15 to 22 - As rows 1 to 8.

Row 23 - Using 4mm needles and
C, k to end.

Row 24 - Using 4mm needles and
C, p to end.

Rows 25 and 26 - As rows 23 and
24.

These 26 rows form the patt. And
are repeated.

Work straight until back measures
35(40:45:50:55)cm from cast on
edge, ending with a wrong side row.

Shoulders

Next row - Cast off 17(20:24:27:31)
sts for right shoulder, k next
31(33:35:37:39) sts and leave these
32(34:36:38:40) sts on a holder for
back neck, k to end. 17(20:24:27:31)
sts.

Buttonband

Using A work 4 rows st st, ending
with a k row.
Cast off k wise.

FRONT

Work as given for Back until 16
rows fewer have been worked than
on Back to shoulder.

Shape front neck

Next row - K21(24:28:31:35), skpo,
turn and work on these sts for first
side of neck.

Next row - P2 togtbl, p to end.

Next row - K to last 2 sts, skpo.
Rep the last 2 rows once more and
the first row again. 17(20:24:27:31)
sts.

Work 4 rows.

Buttonholeband

Continue in A only.

K 4 rows, ending at armhole edge.

Buttonhole row

K5(6:8:9:11), yf, k2tog, k4(5:6:7:8),
k2tog, yf, k4(5:6:7:7).

K 2 rows.

Cast off k wise.

With right side facing, place next
20(22:24:26:28) sts on a holder,
rejoin yarn to rem sts, k2tog, k to
end.

Next row - P to last 2 sts, p2tog.

Next row - K2tog, k to end.
Rep the last 2 rows once more and
the first row again. 17(20:24:27:31)
sts.

Work 9 rows straight.

Cast off.

SLEEVES

Both versions

With 3.25mm needles and A cast on
46(46:50:50:54) sts.

Rib row 1 - K2, [p2, k2] to end.

Rib row 2 - P2, [k2, p2] to end.

These 2 rows form the rib.

Work a further 8(8:10:10:12) rows,
inc 3(1:3:1:3) sts across last row.
49(51:53:55:57) sts.

Fish with bubbles only

Change to 4mm needles.

Starting row 23 work in main stripe
patt as given for Back, **at the same
time**

Work 4(6:6:10:10) rows.

Inc row - K3, m1, k to last 3 sts,
m1, k3.

Work 7 rows.

Rep the last 8 rows 5(6:7:8:9)
times more and the inc row again.
63(67:71:75:79) sts.

Plain Fish only

Beg with a k row work 4 rows C
and 2 rows A in st st.

Inc row - Using A k3, m1, k to last
3 sts, m1, k3. 51(53:55:57:59) sts.

Next row - Using A p to end.

Work in patt from Chart 1(1:2:3:3).

Row 1 - K9(10:9:6:7)A,
k14(14:16:20:20) sts of row
1 of chart 1(1:2:3:3), k5A,

k14(14:16:20:20) sts of row 1 of
chart 1(1:2:3:3), k9(10:9:6:7)A.

Row 2 - P9(10:9:6:7)A,

p14(14:16:20:20) sts of row
2 of chart 1(1:2:3:3), p5A,

p14(14:16:20:20) sts of row 2 of
chart 1(1:2:3:3), p9(10:9:6:7)A.

These 2 rows set the Charts.

Work a further 4 rows.

Inc row - Using A k3, m1, patt to
last 3 sts, m1, k3. 53(55:57:59:61) sts.
Work a further 4(4:6:6:8:8) rows to
complete Chart.

Beg with a p row work 5 rows A
and 4 rows C, in st st **at the same
time** inc one st **as set** at each
end of the 2nd of these 9 rows.
55(57:59:61:63) sts.

Now work in main stripe patt **at
the same time** inc one st **as set** at
each end of the next and 3(4:5:6:7)
foll 8th rows. 63(67:71:75:79) sts.

Both versions

Cont straight until sleeve measures
24(28:32:36:40)cm from cast on
edge, ending with a p row.

Shape top

Next row - Cast off 4 sts, k to end.

Next row - Cast off 4 sts, p to last
2 sts, p2tog.

Next row - Cast off 4 sts, k to last
2 sts, skpo.

Next row - Cast off 4 sts, p to last
2 sts, p2tog.

Next row - Cast off 4(5:6:7:8) sts, k
to last 2 sts, skpo.

Next row - Cast off 4(5:6:7:8) sts, p
to last 2 sts, p2tog.

Rep the last 2 rows once. 24 sts.
Cast off, working skpo over last 2
sts.

NECKBAND

Join right shoulder seam.

With right side facing, using 3.25mm
needles and A pick up and k16 sts
down left side of front neck, k
across 20(22:24:26:28) sts from front
neck, pick up and k16 sts up right

side of front neck, k32(34:36:38:40) sts from back neck holder, pick up and k4 sts along row ends of buttonband. 88(92:96:100:104) sts.
Row 1 - K1, [p2, k2], to last 3 sts, p2, k1.

Row 2 - K3, [p2, k2] to last 5 sts, p2, k3.
 These 2 rows form the rib.
 Work 0(0:0:2:2) more rows.

Buttonhole row

Rib to last 5 sts, k2tog, yrn, p2, k1.
 Rib 4 rows.
 Cast off in rib.

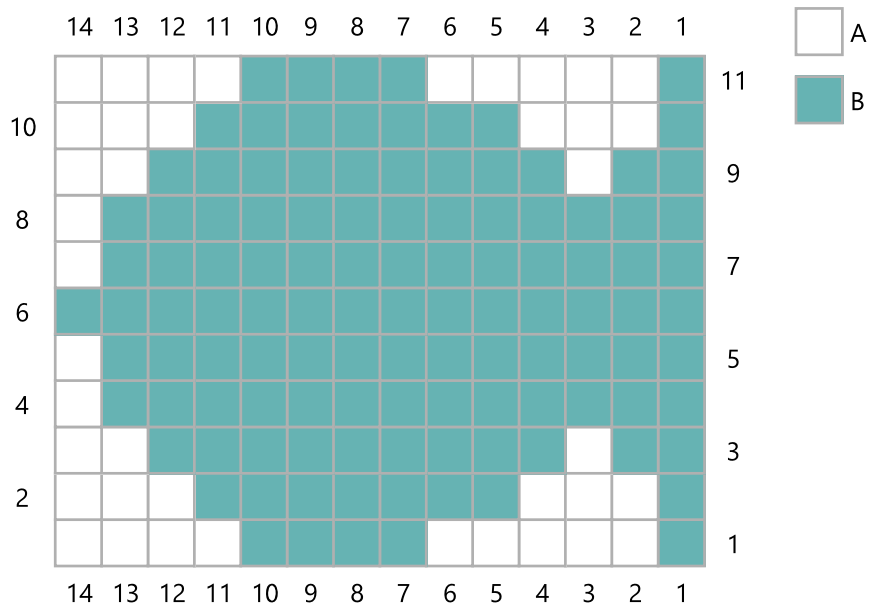
TO MAKE UP

Lap the buttonhole band over the button band and tack in place. Sew on the sleeves. Join the side and sleeve seams. Sew on the buttons.

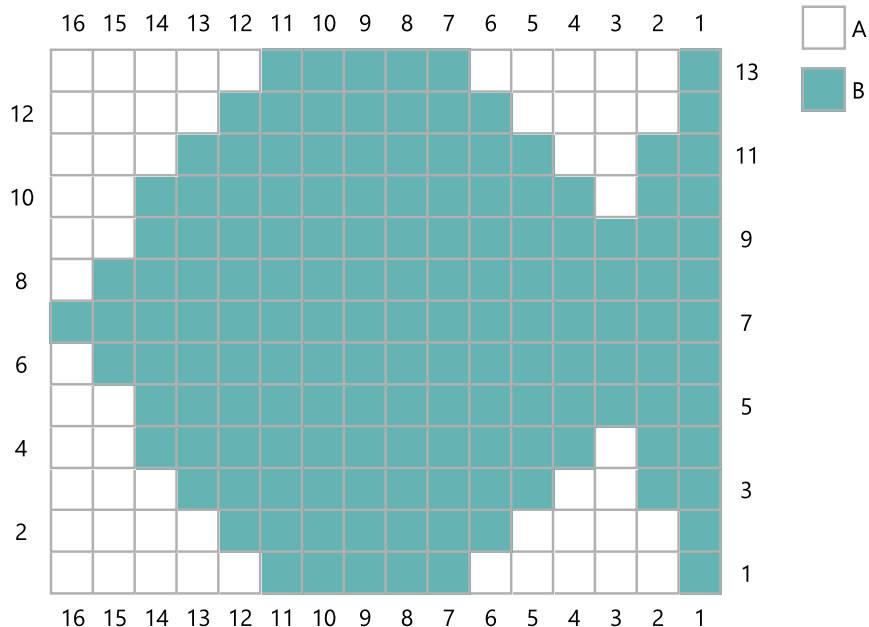
Fish with bubbles jumper

 Using B, embroider French knots for bubbles above the fish.

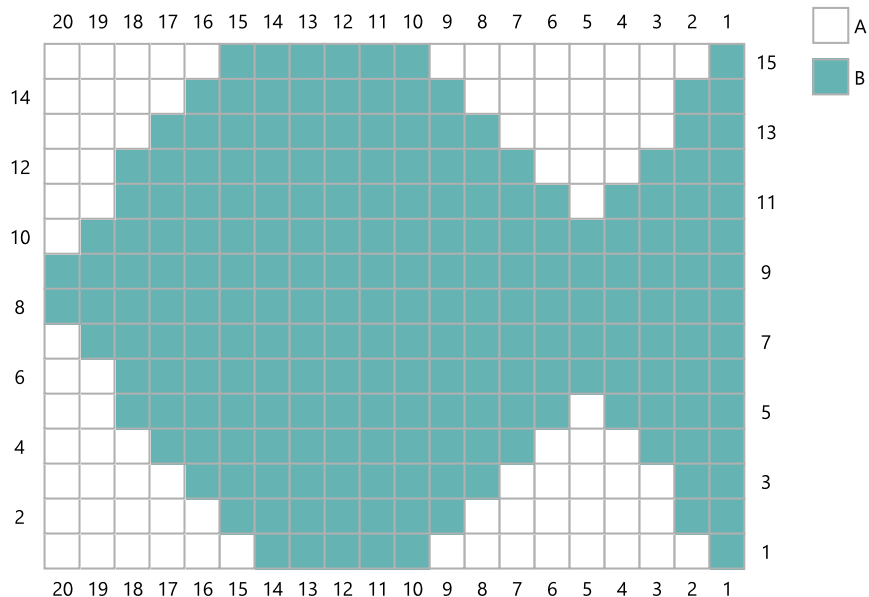
Fish chart 1
