TENSION

22 stitches x 28 rows forms a 10 cm x 10 cm square with 4 mm needles.

ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

K - Knit;

P - Purl;

st(s) - stitch(es);

Stst - Stocking stitch;

Tbl - Through back of loops;

Sl 1 - Slip one stitch;

Yfwd - Yarn forward;

Psso - Pass slipped stitch over;

Yrn - Yarn round needle;

2tog - K or P two stitches together;

M1 - Make one, pick up loop before next st, and K into the back;

Alt - Alternate;

Inc - Increase;

Dec - Decrease;

Beg - Beginning;

Tog - Together;

cm - centimetres;

ins - inches;

RS - Right side;

WS - Wrong side;

0 - No stitches, rows or times to be worked in that particular size.

NOTES

All shaping (except for neck shaping) is worked 2 sts in from ends of rows.

- To **dec** 1 st at **beg** of a **RS** row: K2, K2tog, pattern to end.
- To **dec** 1 st at **end** of a **RS** row: Pattern to last 4 sts, Sl 1, K1, Psso, K2.
- To **dec** 1 st at **beg** of a **WS** row: P2, P2tog Tbl, pattern to end.
- To **dec** 1 st at **end** of a **WS** row: Pattern to last 4 sts, P2tog, P2.
- To **inc** 1 st at **beg** of a **RS** row: K2, M1, pattern to end.
- To **inc** 1 st at **end** of a **RS** row: Pattern to last 2 sts, M1, K2.

PANEL PATTERN (21 sts)

Row 1 (RS) - P2, K8, Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, psso, K7, P2.

2nd and Every Following Alt

Row - K2, P17, K2.

Row 3 - P2, K6, K2tog, Yfwd, K1, Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Psso, K6, P2.

Row 5 - P2, K5, K2tog, Yfwd, K1, [Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Psso] twice, K5, P2.

Row 7 - P2, K4, [K2tog, Yfwd] twice, K1, [Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Psso] twice, K4, P2.

Row 9 - P2, K3, [K2tog, Yfwd] twice, K3, [Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Psso] twice, K3, P2.

Row 11 - P2, K2, [K2tog, Yfwd] twice, K5, [Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Psso] twice, K2, P2.

Row 13 - P2, K1, [K2tog, Yfwd] twice, K7, [Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Psso] twice, K1, P2.

Row 15 - P2, [K2tog, Yfwd] twice, K9, [Yfwd, Sl 1, K1, Psso] twice, P2.

Row 17 - P2, K5, slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and leave at front of work, K4, then K3 from cable needle, K5, P2.

Row 19 - P2, K17, P2.

Row 20 - As 2nd Row.

These 20 rows form panel pattern and are repeated.

CARDIGAN

BACK

Using 4 mm needles, cast on 97 (103, 109, 115, 121, 127) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K1, *P1, K1, repeat from * to end.

Row 2 - P1, *K1, P1, repeat from * to end.

These two rows form rib.

Continue in rib until Back measures 5 cm (2 ins), finishing on a WS row.

Commencing with a K row, continue in Stst throughout as follows:
Work straight until Back measures 30 (31, 31, 32, 31, 32) cm, 11¾ (12¼, 12¼, 12½, 12¼, 12½) ins, finishing on a WS row.

SHAPE ARMHOLES

Cast off 4 (5, 5, 6, 7, 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows 89 (93, 99, 103, 107, 113) sts.

Working all shaping as detailed in notes, continue as follows:

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 (5, 7, 7, 7, 9) rows, then on every following alt row until 73 (75, 77, 79, 81, 83) sts remain.

Continue without further shaping until armholes measure 20 (21, 22, 22, 23, 23) cm, 7¾ (8¼, 8½, 8½, 9, 9) ins, finishing on a WS row.

SHAPE SHOULDERS

Cast off 7 (7, 7, 7, 7, 8) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 7) sts at beg of following 2 rows.

Leave remaining 33 (35, 35, 37, 37, 37) sts on a st holder.

LEFT FRONT

Using 4 mm needles, cast on 46 (48, 52, 54, 58, 60) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - *K1, P1, repeat from * to last 2 sts, K2.

Row 2 - *K1, P1, repeat from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Continue in rib until Left Front measures 5 cm (2 ins), finishing on a WS row and inc 0 (1, 0, 1, 0, 1) st at end of last row 46 (49, 52, 55, 58, 61) sts.

Commence pattern.

Row 1 (RS) - K20 (22, 24, 26, 28, 30), work next 21 sts as given for Row 1 of Panel Pattern, K5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10).

2nd Row - P5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10), work next 21 sts as given for Row 2 of Panel Pattern, P20 (22, 24, 26, 28, 30).

These 2 rows form pattern – panel pattern with Stst either side.

** Continue in pattern as set until Left Front matches Back to start of armhole shaping, finishing on a WS row (For Right Front, work 1 extra row here).

SHAPE ARMHOLE

Keeping pattern correct, cast off 4 (5, 5, 6, 7, 7) sts at beg of next row 42 (44, 47, 49, 51, 54) sts.

Work 1 row (For Right Front, omit this row).

Working all shaping as detailed in notes, continue as follows:

Dec 1 st at armhole edge on next 5 (5, 7, 7, 7, 9) rows, then on every following alt row until 34 (35, 36, 37, 38, 39) sts remain.

Continue without further shaping until armhole measures 13 (14, 15, 14, 15, 15) cm, 5 (5½, 6, 5½, 6, 6) ins, finishing at front opening edge.

SHAPE NECK

Keeping pattern correct, cast off 6 (6, 6, 7, 7, 7) sts at beg on next row 28 (29, 30, 30, 31, 32) sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on every row until 20 (20, 21, 21, 22, 23) sts remain.

Continue without further shaping until Left Front matches Back to start of shoulder shaping, finishing at armhole edge.

SHAPE SHOULDER

Cast off 7 (7, 7, 7, 7, 8) sts at beg of next and following alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off remaining 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 7) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 4 mm needles, cast on 46 (48, 52, 54, 58, 60) sts.

Row 1 (RS) - K2, *P1, K1, repeat from * to end.

Row 2 - *P1, K1, repeat from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Continue in rib until Right Front measures 5 cm (2 ins), finishing on a WS row and inc 0 (1, 0, 1, 0, 1) st at beg of last row 46 (49, 52, 55, 58, 61) sts.

Commence pattern.

Row 1 (RS) - K5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10), work next 21 sts as given for Row 1 of Panel Pattern, K20 (22, 24, 26, 28, 30).

Row 2 - P20 (22, 24, 26, 28, 30), work next 21 sts as given for Row 2 of Panel Pattern, P5 (6, 7, 8, 9, 10).

These 2 rows form pattern - panel pattern with Stst either side.

Complete to match Left Front from **, noting the bracketed exceptions.

SLEEVES (BOTH ALIKE)

Using 4 mm needles, cast on 43 (45, 47, 49, 51, 53) sts.

Work 5 cm (2 ins) in rib as given for Back, finishing on a WS row.

Commencing with a K row, continue in Stst throughout as follows:

Working all shaping as detailed in note, inc 1 st at each end of 7th (5th, 5th, 5th, 5th, 7th) and every following 8th (6th, 6th, 6th, 6th, 8th) row until there are 67 (51, 51, 53, 55, 81) sts.

For 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only:

Inc 1 st at each end of every following 10th (8th, 8th, 8th, 8th) row until there are 69 (73, 75, 77, 79) sts.

FOR ALL SIZES

Continue without further shaping until Sleeve measures 43 (43, 44, 44, 44, 45) cm, 17 (17, 17¼, 17¼, 17¼, 17¾) ins, finishing on a WS row.

SHAPE TOP

Cast off 4 (5, 5, 6, 7, 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows 61 (63, 65, 65, 65, 67) sts.

Working all shaping as detailed in

special note, continue as follows-

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on following 2 alt rows, then on every following 4th row until 47 (49, 49, 49, 45, 49) sts remain.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and following 8 (9, 8, 8, 4, 6) alt rows,

then on following 5 (5, 5, 5, 7, 7) rows, thus finishing on a WS row.

Cast off remaining 19 (19, 21, 21, 21, 21) sts.

MAKING UP

Join shoulder seams by top-sewing.

NECK BORDER

With RS facing and using 4 mm needles, pick up and K23 (23, 23, 27, 27) sts up right side of neck, K across 33 (35, 35, 37, 37, 37) sts left on back neck st holder, pick up and K23 (23, 23, 27, 27, 27) sts down left side of neck 79 (81, 81, 91, 91, 91) sts.

Commencing first (WS) row with “K1”, work in rib as given for Back for 7 rows.

Cast off in rib.

BUTTON BORDER

With RS facing and using 4 mm needles, pick up and K103 (107, 111, 111, 111, 115) sts along entire left front opening edge, between top of Neck Border and cast-on edge.

Commencing first (WS) row with “P1”, work in rib as given for Back for 7 rows.

Cast off in rib.

BUTTONHOLE BORDER

Work to match Button Border, picking up sts along right front opening edge and with the addition of 5 buttonholes in 4th row as follows:

Row 4 (RS) - Rib 3, *Yrn (to make a buttonhole), work 2 tog, rib 22 (23, 24, 24, 24, 25), rep from * to last 4 sts, Yrn (to make 5th buttonhole), work 2 tog, rib 2.

Join side seams by top-sewing.

Join sleeve seams by top-sewing.

Insert Sleeves.

Sew on buttons.

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
