



EASY HOODED SCARF

Skill Level: **EASY**

Pattern: **M25065 MDG**



LION BRAND® MANDALA® GRADIENT EASY HOODED SCARF

EASY

SIZE

Finished Scarf Width About 6 1/2 in. (16.5 cm)

Finished Scarf Length About 38 1/2 in. (98 cm),
after folding and seaming

Finished Hood Depth About 10 in. (25.5 cm), at
widest

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® MANDALA® GRADIENT (Art. #558)
- #214 Burgundy 2 cakes
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Knitting needles size 6 (4 mm)

GAUGE

20 sts + 26 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over St
st (k on RS, p on WS).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATIONS

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st
without removing it from left needle, then knit
through back of same st – 1 st increased.

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative
hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle.
This creates the new st. You are now ready
to proceed with the next st as instructed.

NOTES

1. Hooded Scarf is worked in one piece from
one end of Scarf to opposite end.
2. At center of Scarf, sts are increased then
decreased to shape Hood. Piece is folded in
half and edges seamed for back of Hood.

3. Scarf is worked in Garter st (k every st of
every row), Hood is worked in St st (k on
RS, p on WS) with a Garter st front edge.
4. When you see work 'even' in the
instructions, this means to continue on in
the pattern st you have established without
changing the st count by increasing,
decreasing, or binding off.

HOODED SCARF

First Half of Scarf

Cast on 4 sts.

Row 1 (RS): K to last st, yo, k1 – you will have
5 sts in this row. Place a marker on this row to
indicate RS of piece.

Row 2: K1, yo, k to end of row – 6 sts.

Row 3: K to last st, yo, k1 – 7 sts.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until you have 32 sts, end
with a WS row as the last row you work.

Work in Garter st (k every st of every row) until
piece measures about 22 in. (56 cm) from beg,
end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Shape Hood

Increase row (RS): K to last 10 sts, kfb, k to end
of row – 33 sts.

Next row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows for 10 more times – 43 sts when
all increases have been completed.

Next row (RS): Rep Increase row – 44 sts.

Next row: P to last 10 sts, place marker (pm),
k10 (for front edge).

Rep last 2 rows for 6 more times, slipping
marker as you come to it – 50 sts when all
increases have been completed.

Place a marker on the last Increase row
worked. Continue to slip front edge marker as
you come to it.

Next row (RS): Knit.

Next row: P to marker, slip marker (sm), k to
end of row.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures about 21 in. (53.5 cm) from Increase row marker, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Decrease row (RS): K to last 10 sts, k2tog through back loops, k to end of row – 49 sts.

Next row: P to marker, sm, k to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows for 5 more times, remove front edge marker when working last row – 44 sts when all decreases have been completed.

Next row (RS): Rep Decrease row – 43 sts.

Next row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows for 10 more times – 33 sts when all decreases have been completed.

Place a marker on the last Decrease row worked.

Second Half of Scarf

Work in Garter st until piece measures about 20 in. (51 cm) from Decrease row marker, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Next row (RS): K to last 4 sts, k2tog, yo, k2tog – 32 sts.

Next row: K2tog, yo, k2tog, k to end of row – 31 sts.

Rep last 2 rows until only 4 sts remain.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Fold piece in half. Sew curved edges together for back of Hood.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side
