Sizes U.S. 8 (5 mm) and U.S. 9 (5.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® knitting needles. Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® circular knitting needle 16" [40.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge**. 2 Susan Bates® stitch holders. Susan Bates® stitch markers. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

GAUGES

17 sts and 18 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Chevron Pat with larger needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate(ing)

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Cont = Continue(ity)

Dec = Decreas(es)(ing)

Double Inc = Double increase by knitting into the front, back and front again of same stitch

Inc = Increase(ing)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

Kfb = Knit into front and back of next stitch

P = Purl

P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches together

P2togtbl = Purl next 2 stitches together through back loops

Pat = Pattern

PM = Place marker

Pssso = Pass slipped stitch over

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Slk = Slip next stitch knitwise

Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for **XS/S**. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written **XS/S (M-L-XL-2/3XL-4/5XL)**. Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

FRONT

See diagrams pages 6-11.

With smaller needles and A, cast on **82 (90-98-114-130-146) sts.

1st row: (RS). *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

2nd row: *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P2.

Rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing until work from beg measures 2" [5 cm], ending on a RS row.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:

Set up row: (WS). With B, purl, inc 1 st in center of row. **83 (91-99-115-131-147)** sts.

Proceed in Chevron Pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). K1. K2tog. K2. *Double inc. K2. Slk. K2tog. Pssso. K2. Rep from * to last 6 sts. Double inc. K2. K2tog. K1.

2nd row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows for Chevron Pat until work from beg measures approx **11 (11-11-12-12-12)" [28 (28-28-30.5-30.5-30.5) cm]**, ending on a RS row.

NOTES for armhole shaping:

- To maintain proper stitch count, careful attention must be made to needed adjustments in the inc and dec sts worked at beg and end of each row. Refer to chart pertaining to your size for these adjustments in pat.
- Once initial Armhole sts have been cast off, dec shaping is worked on WS (purl) rows.

Shape armholes: 1st row: (WS). Cast off **6 (6-9-9-8-8)** sts. Purl to end of row. **77 (85-90-106-123-139)** sts.

2nd row: Cast off **6 (6-9-9-8-8)** sts. Pat to end of row (see chart). **71 (79-81-97-115-131)** sts.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only: 3rd and 4th rows: Rep last 2 rows once more. **(99-115)** sts at end of 4th row.

All sizes: Shape armholes: 1st row: (WS). P1. P2tog. Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1. **69 (77-79-95-97-113)** sts.

2nd and alt rows: Pat to end of row (See chart).

Rep last 2 rows **6 (8-8-12-10-15)** times more. **57 (61-63-71-77-83)** sts.**

Cont working Chart on these **57 (61-63-71-77-83)** sts until Armhole measures **6 (6-7-7-8-8)" [15 (15-18-18-20.5-20.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row.

Shape left neck: Keeping cont of Chart, proceed as follows:

1st row:(RS). Pat across **16** (**18-18-22-24-27**) (see chart). K2tog. K1. **Turn**. Place rem sts on a st holder. **18** (**20-20-24-26-29**) sts.

2nd row: P1. P2tog. Purl to end of row. **17** (**19-19-23-25-28**) sts.

3rd row: Pat to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. **16** (**18-18-22-24-27**) sts.

Dec at neck edge every row twice more to **14** (**16-16-20-22-25**) sts, then at neck edge on every RS row only to **10** (**12-12-16-18-21**) sts.

Next row: Purl.

Cast off rem **10** (**12-12-16-18-21**) sts.

Place next **19** (**19-21-21-23-23**) sts on st holder for front neck.

Shape right neck: With RS facing, larger needles and B, proceed on rem **19** (**21-21-25-27-30**) sts as follows:

1st row: (RS). K1. ssk. Pat to end of row. **18** (**20-20-24-26-29**) sts.

2nd row: Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1. **17** (**19-19-23-25-28**) sts.

3rd row: K1. ssk. Pat to end of row. **16** (**18-18-22-24-27**) sts.

Dec at neck edge every row twice more to **14** (**16-16-20-22-25**) sts, then at neck edge on every RS row only to **10** (**12-12-16-18-21**) sts.

Next row: Purl.

Cast off rem **10** (**12-12-16-18-21**) sts.

BACK

Work from ** to ** as given for Front.

Cont working Chart on these **57** (**61-63-71-77-83**) sts until armhole measures 4 rows less than Front, ending on a WS (purl) row.

Shape back right neck: 1st row: (RS). **K11** (**13-13-17-19-21**). K2tog. K1. **Turn**. Leave rem sts on a st holder. **13** (**15-15-19-21-23**) sts.

2nd row: P1. P2tog. Purl to end of row. **12** (**14-14-18-20-22**) sts.

3rd row: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. **11** (**13-13-17-19-21**) sts.

4th row: As 2nd row.

Cast off rem **10** (**12-12-16-18-20**) sts (RS).

Place next **29** (**29-31-31-33-35**) sts on a st holder for back neck.

Shape back left neck: With RS facing, larger needles and B, proceed as follows on rem **14** (**16-16-20-22-24**) sts:

1st row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to end of row. **13** (**15-15-19-21-23**) sts.

2nd row: Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1. **12** (**14-14-18-20-22**) sts.

3rd row: K1. ssk. Knit to end of row. **11** (**13-13-17-19-21**) sts.

4th row: As 2nd row.

Cast off rem **10** (**12-12-16-18-20**) sts (RS).

FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Sew shoulder seams.

Armbands: With RS facing, smaller needles and A, pick up and knit **74 (74-90-90-106-106)** sts evenly along armhole edge.

1st row: (WS). *P2. K2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P2.

2nd row: *K2. P2. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

Rep last 2 rows of (K2. P2) ribbing until work from pick up row measures 1" [2.5 cm], ending on a WS row.

Cast off in pat (RS).

Rep for other armhole.

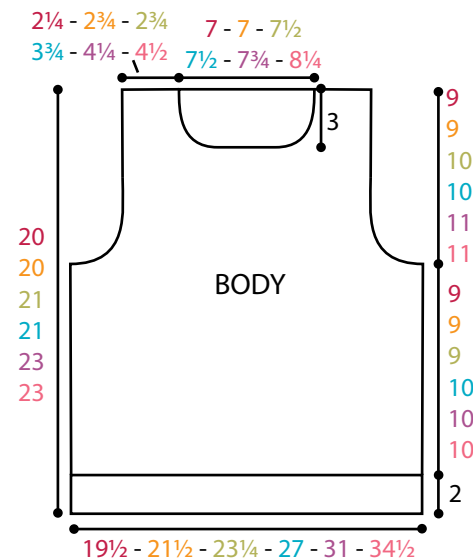
Sew side and armband seams.

Neckband: With RS facing, smaller circular needle and A, beg at Left shoulder, pick up and knit 12 sts down left front neck edge. K**19 (19-21-21-23-23)** from front neck st holder. Pick up and knit 12 sts up right front neck edge. Pick up and knit 2 sts down right back neck. K**29 (29-31-31-33-35)** from back neck st holder, dec **0 (0-0-0-0-2)** sts evenly along back neck. Pick up and knit 2 sts up left back neck. **76 (76-80-80-84-84)** sts. Join in rnd. PM for beg of rnd.

1st rnd: *K2. P2. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd of (K2. P2) ribbing until Neckband measures 1½" [4 cm], ending on a WS row.

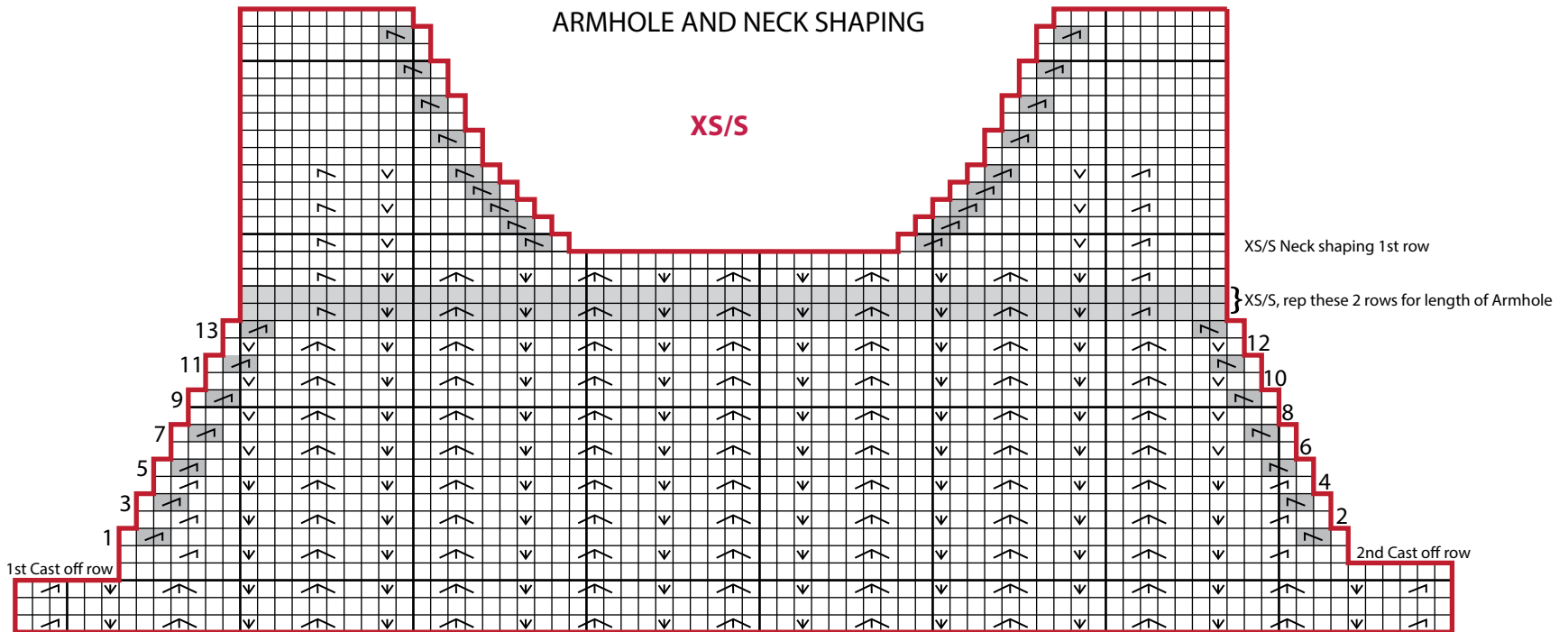
Cast off in pat.



FRONT



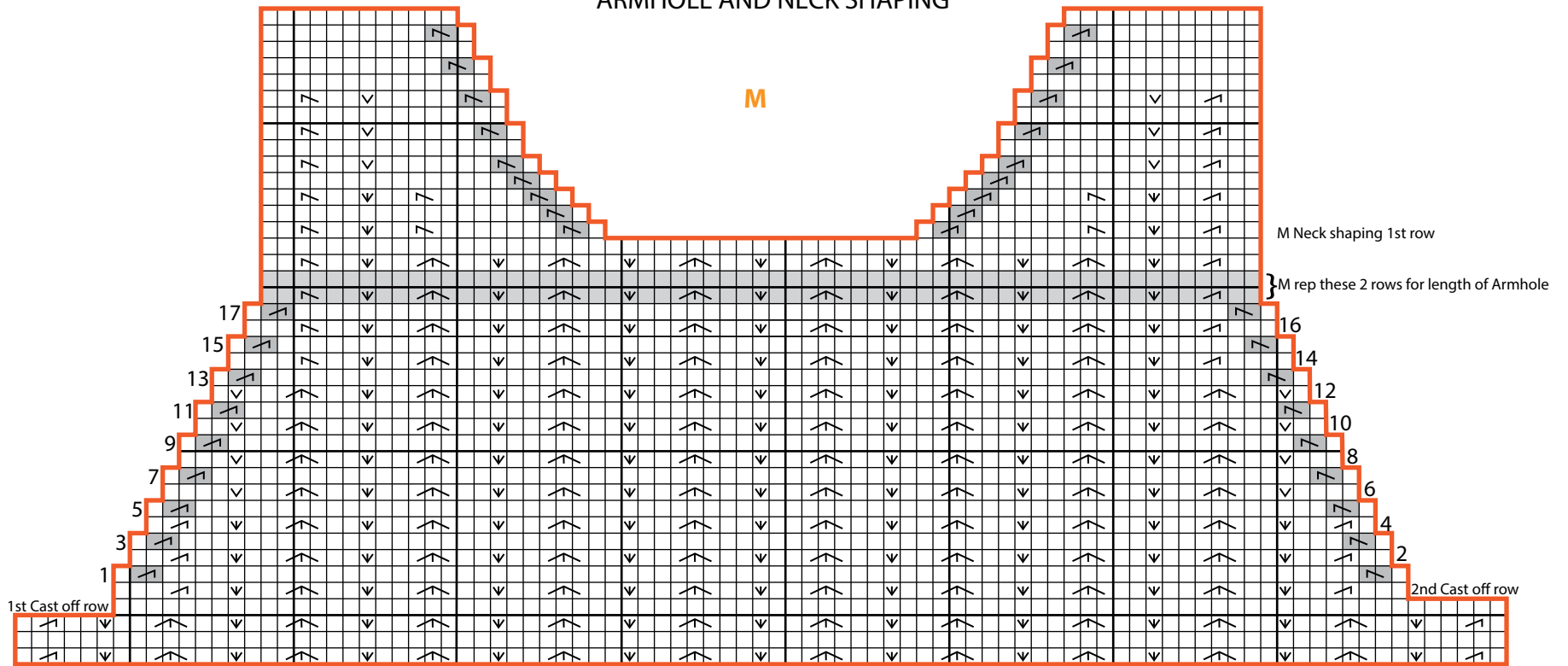

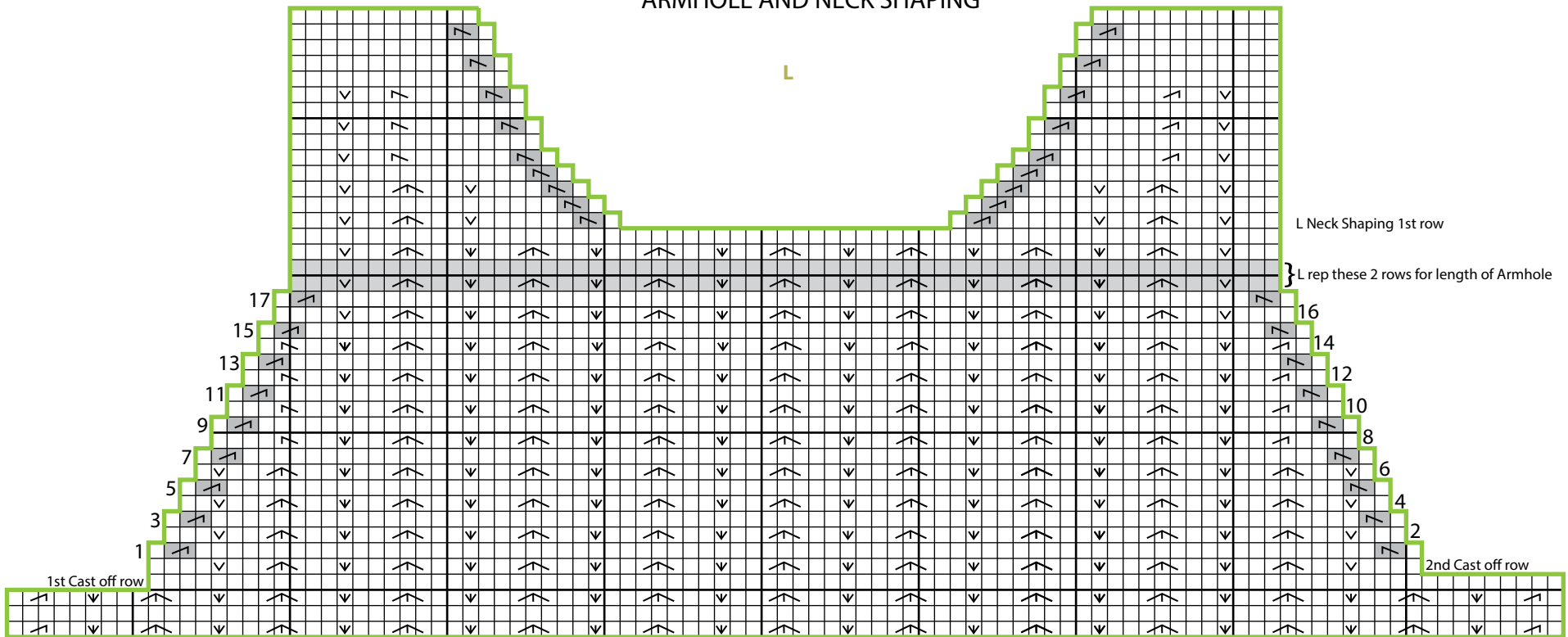
ARMHOLE AND NECK SHAPING

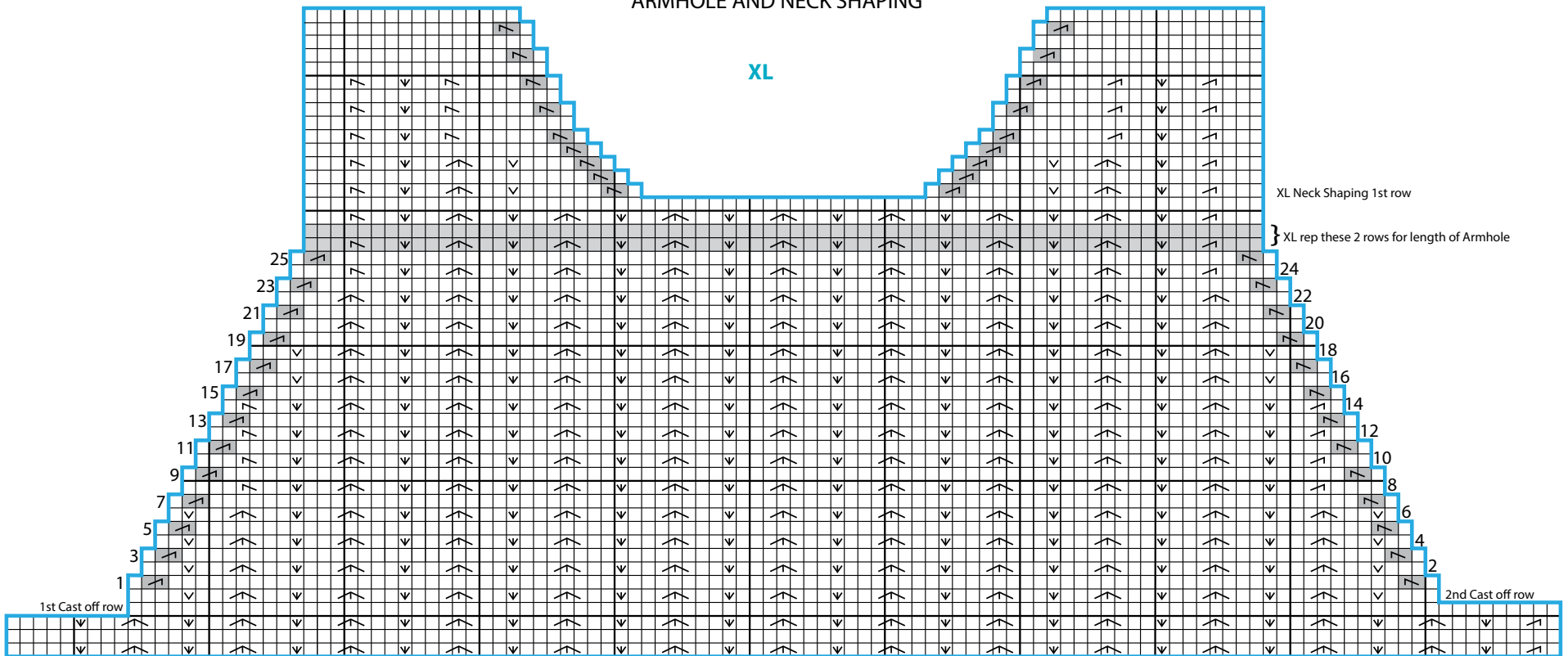

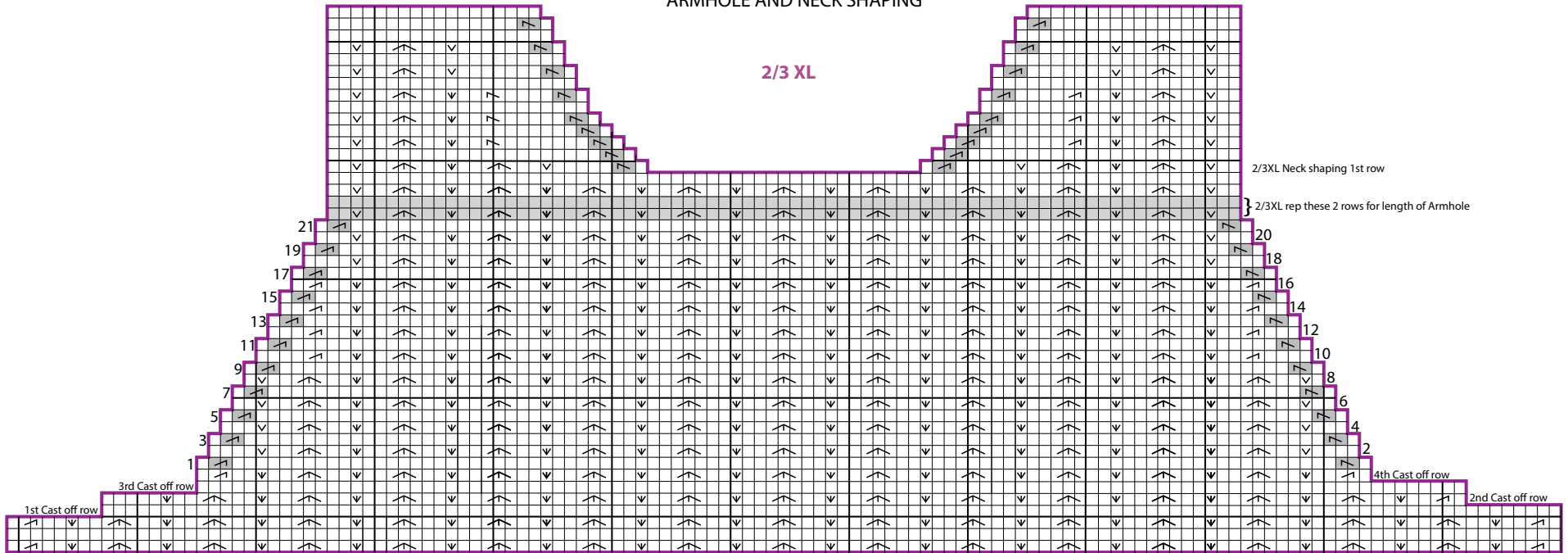

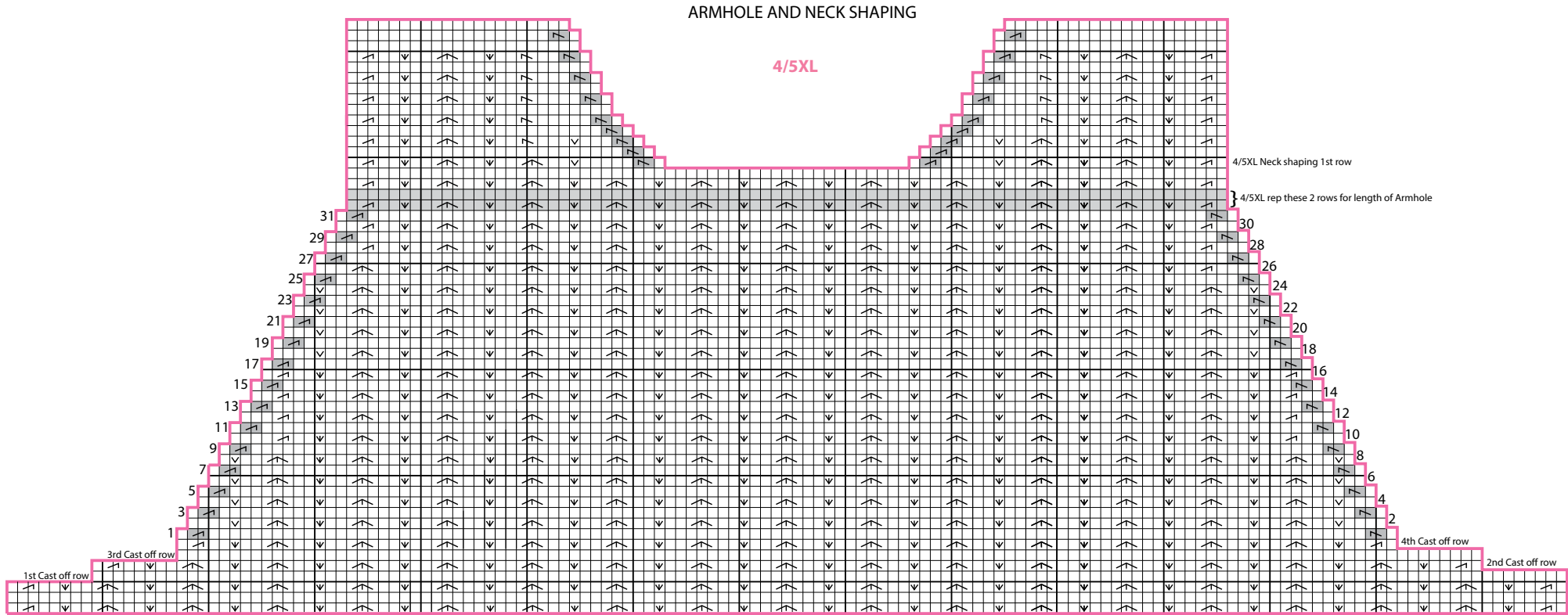
ARMHOLE AND NECK SHAPING
