3.5mm Crochet Hook

GAUGE

Gauge: 4" (10.25cm) = 18Tr x 8 rows

Please note that the gauge is not critical for this pattern

ABBREVIATIONS (UK)

Ch – Chain

Dc – Double Crochet

Htr – Half Treble

Tr – Treble

FPTR – Front Post Treble

STTR – Standing Treble

Tr2tog – Treble Two Together

Sl st – Slip Stitch

Sk – Skip

Sp – Space

BAG PANEL

Using your Main Colour and a 3.5mm crochet hook, Ch 54.

Htr in 2nd chain from hook and along, (53 Htr) Ch1, turn.

Row 2 - Htr in first and all along (53 Htr). Ch1 and turn

Rows 3 to 11 - Repeat row 2

Row 12 - Edging the rectangle to form the base.

Side 1 - Htr 16 evenly along edge

Corner - 3 Htr in first corner

Bottom - Htr in next 51 stitches (bottom of starting chain)

Corner - 3 Htr in last stitch

Side 2 - Htr 16 evenly along next side

Corner - 3 Htr in first stitch of top edge

Top - Htr in next 51 stitches

Last corner - 3 Htr in last stitch
Sl st to join. (146 Htr)

Row 13 - Ch 1, Htr in back and 3rd loop of the first Htr and each Htr around. Sl st to join. Ch 1 (146 Htr)

Rows 14 & 15 - Ch 1, Htr around, Sl st to join. (146 Htr)

Row 16 - STTR in 3rd loop of Htr below, Tr in 3rd loop of Htr below all around. Sl st to join (146 Tr)

Row 17 - STTR, Tr 17, FPTR, *Tr, Ch 1, Sk 1 St,* Tr in next, repeat from * to * 25 times, FPTR in next. 18 Tr, FPTR, Repeat from * to * 26 times, Tr in next, FPTR in last. Sl st to join. (146 St)

Row 18 - Top Tip - TR around the Ch Sp rather than the top of the Ch. STTR, Tr2tog, 13 Tr, Tr2tog, FPTR, Tr, *Ch1, Sk1, Tr 9* Repeat from * to * 4 times, Ch1, Sk1, Tr, FPTR. Tr, Tr2tog, 13 Tr, Tr2tog, FPTR, Tr, *Ch1, Sk1, Tr 9* Repeat from * to * 4 times, Ch1, Sk1, Tr, FPTR. Sl st to join. (142 St)

Row 19 - STTR, 15 Tr, FPTR, Tr, *Ch1, Sk1, Tr 9* Repeat from * to * 4 times, Ch1, Sk1, Tr, FPTR. 16 Tr, FPTR, Tr, *Ch1, Sk1, Tr 9* Repeat from * to * 4 times, Ch1, Sk1, Tr, FPTR. Sl st to join. (142 St)

Rows 20 to 21 - Repeat row 19

Row 22 - STTR, Tr 15, FPTR, *Tr, Ch 1, Sk 1*, Tr in next, repeat from * to * 25 times, FPTR in next. 16 Tr, FPTR, repeat from * to * 26 times, FPTR in last. Sl st to join. (142 St)

Row 23 - STTR, 15 Tr, FPTR, Tr, *Ch1, Sk1, Tr 9* Repeat from * to * 4 times, Ch1, Sk1, Tr, FPTR 16 Tr, FPTR, Tr, *Ch1, Sk1, Tr 9* repeat from * to * 4 times, Ch1, Sk1, Tr, FPTR. Sl st to join. (142 St)

Rows 24 to 26 - Repeat Row 23

Rows 27 to 41 - Repeat Row 22–26

three more times – you will have 5 pattern repeats in total.

Row 42 - STTR, Tr 15, FPTR, *Tr, Ch 1, Sk 1*, Tr in next, repeat from * to * 25 times, FPTR in next. 16 Tr, FPTR, Repeat from * to * 26 times, FPTR in last Sl st to join. (142 St)

Row 43 - STTR, Tr 15, FPTR, Tr 53, FPTR, Tr 16, FPTR, Tr 53, FPTR in last Sl st to join Ch 1 (142 St)

Row 44 - Dc in each stitch. Sl st to join, Ch 1 (142 Dc)

Row 45 - Dc 24, Ch 70, skip 39 stitches, Dc 32, Ch 70, skip 39 stitches, Dc 8. Sl st to join Ch 1 (64 Dc, 140 Ch)

Row 46 - Dc 24, Dc 72 around the chain (See note below), Dc 32, Dc 72 around the chain, Dc 8 Sl st to join (208 St)

Please note Check how the 72 Dc looks and adjust if necessary; adding/removing stitches will change the total stitch count.

Row 47 - Change to colour A. Ch 1, Dc in each stitch, Sl st to join (208 St)

Note - The stitch count may have changed if you added/removed Dc on the handles.

Rows 48 to 54 - Change colour on each round B–G, ending with colour A. Ch 1, Dc in each stitch, Sl st to join. (208 St)

COLOURED CHAINS

Option 1

Start with yarn A.

Ch 42 and check that these fit your panel.

You will be threading the chain through the Tr, Ch 1 sections as if they are a ribbon and securing them inside, so you don't want them too long. (Repeat process with your other yarn colours.)

Option 2

Start with yarn A.

Join yarn to the inside of the bag, making sure the join cannot be seen from the right side.

Ch 1 and Dc, then chain to the correct length, weave the chain as if it is a ribbon and connect with a Dc at the other side, again being careful this does not show on the right side.

(Repeat process with your other yarn colours.)

For both options, sew in all ends.

You will need a total of 24 coloured chains.
