



## Cotton Drops Poppy Cushion

### CY1932

#### Materials

Cygnets Cotton Drops Chunky 200g - Black Rock 5299 x 1 ball and 2 in a colour of your choice (shown here in Smoked Copper 5111, Red Velvet 6000 and Raspberry Splash 6111)

Crochet Hook: 7mm

250g toy filling, sewing up needle, (Fabric to make cushion inner is optional)

## TENSION

Your black centre circle should measure 12cm in diameter to work to tension however, if you find your stitches are too open, then drop a hook size.

## IT IS IMPORTANT TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE REQUIRED MEASUREMENTS

### Abbreviations

ch = chain; cm = centimetres; dc = double crochet; inc = double crochet twice into the next stitch; dec = insert hook into next st and pull yarn through, insert hook into following st and pull yarn through, yrh and pull through 3sts on hook; flo = front loop only

**Please note the ch1 at the start of each round and row does not count as a stitch**

## Pattern

**Front and back (make 2 pieces the same)**

### Making the poppy centre (make 2)

Using Black Rock and 7mm hook, make a magic ring.

**Round 1:** Ch1, 6dc into ring. (6sts)

**Round 2:** Ch1, 2dc in each dc (inc), insert stitch marker in the first stitch to mark the start of each round. (12sts)

**Round 3:** Ch1, (1dc, inc in next stitch) 6 times. (18sts)

**Round 4:** Ch1, (2dc, inc in next stitch) 6 times. (24sts)

**Round 5:** Ch1, (3dc, inc in next stitch) 6 times. (30sts)

**Rounds 6:** Ch1, (4dc, inc in next stitch) 6 times. (36sts)

Fasten off yarn. Centre should measure approx. 12cm diameter.

### Making the petals (make 4)

Using petal colour with 7mm hook join yarn into any stitch on the last round of Black Rock.

**Row 1:** Ch1, working in the flo 2dc into the stitch you have joined your yarn into. Work 1dc into the flo of the next 7sts and the work 2dc into the flo into the 8<sup>th</sup> stitch. Turn. (11sts)

**Row 2:** Working back along these 9sts, Ch1. Working through both loops from now on, work 2dc into the first stitch, 1dc into each of the next 9sts and 2dc into the last stitch. Turn. (13sts)

**Row 3:** Ch1. Work 2dc into the first stitch, 1dc into each of the next 11sts and 2dc into the last stitch. Turn. (15sts)

**Rows 4 - 10:** Ch1. Work 1dc into each of the stitches to the end of the row. Turn. (15sts)

**Row 11:** Ch1. Work 1dec, then work 1 dc to the last 2sts and work 1 dec. Turn. (13sts)

**Row 12:** Ch1. Work 1dc into each of the stitches to the end of the row. Turn. (13sts)

**Row 13:** Ch1. Work 1dec, then work 1 dc into each of the stitches to the last 2sts and work 1 dec. Turn. (11sts)

**Row 14:** Ch1. Work 1dec, then work 1 dc into each of the stitches to the last 2sts and work 1 dec. Turn. (9sts)

**Row 15:** Ch1. Work 1dec, then work 1 dc into each of the stitches to the last 2sts and work 1 dec. Turn. (7sts)

**Row 16:** Ch1. Work 1dec, then work 1 dc into each of the stitches to the last 2sts and work 1 dec. Cut yarn and fasten off. (5sts)

Working anticlockwise, join yarn into next stitch in the poppy centre, and repeat rows 1-16 for each of the next three petals.

**When you complete your second piece do not fasten off yarn.**

### **Making up the cushion**

**Add toy filling to each petal as you complete the round of dc joining the front and back of the petal together. Ensure cushion is fully filled before you fasten off yarn. (If you are making a fabric inner cushion, cut two pieces of fabric the same size as your first cushion piece. Sew these pieces together and fill the inner cushion, ensuring it is between both the front and back pieces of your cushion before you crochet them together)**

Matching up petals of both front and back pieces, with wrong sides of the work together and with yarn still attached to second piece, chain1. Working through both pieces at a time, dc in each stitch around the edge of the front and back pieces of your cushion, joining them together as you go. When you reach where the petal joins the black centre, work 1dc into round 6 (the last black round) where your last increase on the first petal row is placed and work 1 dc into the stitch on round 6 where your first increase for the next petal is. When you have completed the dc's around your cushion, cut yarn and fasten off.

Your cushion is finished and ready to display!
